- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 21 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 22 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this

- 24 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 25 Office of State Public Defender shall maintain complete accounting
- 26 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 27 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 28 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 29 2016. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 30 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2018 shall be submitted to

47	or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for

49	SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
50	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
51	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
52	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2016; and shall stand repealed from and after June 30, 2016.

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

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
