5	SECTION 1. Th	ne following sum, or so muc	n thereof as may be

12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of		
13	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:

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19 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 20 responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2018 do not 21 22 exceed Fiscal Year 2017 funds appropriated for that purpose, 23 unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 24 2017 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel 25 26 Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to 27 fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 28 29 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 30 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2017 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the 31 32 exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 33 34 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 35 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2017 "Personal Services" 36 37 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 38 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 39 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 40 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State

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44 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 45 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 46 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 47 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 48 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 49 appropriated level.

50 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 51 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 52 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 53 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

58 SECTION 3. None of the funds herein appropriated by this act 59 to the Public Service Commission shall be expended for any purpose 60 that is not actually required or necessary for performing any of 61 the powers or duties of the Mississippi Public Service Commission 62 that are authorized by the Mississippi Constitution of 1890, state 63 or federal law, or rules or regulations that implement state or 64 federal law.

65 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 66 Public Service Commission shall maintain complete accounting and 67 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 68 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the

69 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 70 2016. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 71 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2018 shall be submitted to 72 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 73 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 74 during the Fiscal Year 2017 budget request process.

75 SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein 76 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 77 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury 78 to the credit of the Public Service Commission, for the purpose of 79 defraying the expenses of the Public Service Commission to 80 administer the Mississippi Telephone Solicitation Act, for the 81 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017..... 82 200,000.00. . . . . . . . .

83 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that 84 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 85 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 86 87 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 88 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 89 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 90 made without competitive bids.

91 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 92 Public Service Commission shall compile the amount of time that is 93 expended on each regulated entity during Fiscal Year 2016. On or

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94 before August 1, 2016, the Public Service Commission shall report 95 these findings to the House of Representatives' Public Utilities 96 Committee.

97 The money herein appropriated shall be paid by SECTION 8. the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 98 99 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 100 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 101 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 102 103 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 104 and after July 1, 2016; and shall stand repealed from and after June 30, 2016. 105
