1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI AUTHORITY FOR EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
7	Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the
8	expenses of the Mississippi Authority for Educational Television
9	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, and ending
10	June 30, 2017\$ 5,315,124.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in
13	the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Authority for
14	Educational Television which is comprised of special source funds
15	collected by or otherwise available to the Authority, for the
16	purpose of defraying the expenses of the Authority for the fiscal
17	year beginning July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017
18	\$ 11,176,040.00.

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SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1 and Section 2, the following positions are authorized: AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:

26 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 27 responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2018 do not 28 29 exceed Fiscal Year 2017 funds appropriated for that purpose, 30 unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 31 2017 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data 32 provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel 33 Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to 34 fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the 35 provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 36 37 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2017 38 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the 39 exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at 40 the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 41 42 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2017 "Personal Services" 43

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44 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 45 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 46 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 47 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

48 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 49 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 50 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 51 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 52 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 53 54 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 55 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 56 appropriated level.

57 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 58 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 59 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 60 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

Funds appropriated herein shall first be used for the continuation of a full and complete broadcast schedule of educational and instructional, professional growth, and public

68 service programs, with the production of new films and programs to 69 be secondary thereto.

70 It is the intention of the Legislature that the SECTION 4. Mississippi Authority for Educational Television shall maintain 71 72 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 73 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 74 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2016. It is further the intention of 75 76 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 77 2018 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 78 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 79 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2017 budget request 80 process.

81 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 82 Section 2, Two Million One Hundred Eighteen Thousand Nine Hundred 83 Sixty-Six Dollars (\$2,118,966.00) shall be derived from the 84 Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 85 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 6. No part of the funds appropriated herein shall be transferred to, expended by, or used, directly or indirectly, for the benefit of any public relations, publicity or publication activities of any other state agency, department or officer, nor shall any personnel paid or equipment purchased with funds appropriated hereby be transferred or assigned to any other state

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92 agency, department or officer for public relations, publicity or 93 publication activities of such office.

94 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 95 Mississippi Authority for Educational Television shall have the 96 authority to expend funds in the Capital Equipment Replacement 97 Revolving Fund, in accordance with Section 37-63-17, Mississippi 98 Code of 1972, for the purpose of purchasing technical equipment 99 for operating the educational radio and television facilities.

SECTION 8. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

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A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee for Fiscal Year 2018.

150 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that 151 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 152 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 153 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 154 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 155 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 156 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 157 made without competitive bids.

158 **SECTION 10.** It is the intention of the Legislature that an 159 amount equal to One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per square foot 160 shall be paid to the Executive Office of the State Board of 161 Institutions of Higher Learning to defray utility costs.

162 **SECTION 11.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the 163 Authority for Educational Television may fund a program to focus 164 on the manufacturing industry in Mississippi.

165 SECTION 12. The amount of funds appropriated from the State
166 General Fund in this bill are conditioned upon the availability

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167 for appropriation of the full amount of the state general funds 168 that were projected in the general fund revenue estimate for 169 fiscal year 2017 that was determined under the provision of 170 Section 27-103-125.

171 If the amount of general funds projected to be available for 172 appropriation for fiscal year 2017 would be reduced by the enactment into law of any revenue bills, as defined in Joint Rule 173 174 40, that have been passed by the House of Representatives by March 175 17, 2016, then the amount of funds appropriated from the State General Fund in this bill shall be reduced by the same percentage 176 177 reduction in the amount of general funds that would be available 178 for appropriation for fiscal year 2017, and the reduced amount 179 shall be engrossed into this bill before it is transmitted to 180 Senate.

The determination of whether the House has passed any such revenue bills by March 17, 2016, and the amount and percentage of the resulting reduction in the amount of general funds projected to be available for appropriation for fiscal year 2017, shall be determined by the Legislative Budget Office and certified in writing to the Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee by the Director of the Legislative Budget Office.

188 **SECTION 13.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 189 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 190 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 191 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

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Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 14. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2016; and shall stand repealed from and after June 30, 2016.

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
