## HOUSE BILL NO. 1647

1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
7	Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the
8	expenses of the Department of Archives and History for the fiscal
9	year beginning July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017
10	\$ 10,191,686.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in
13	the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of Archives and
14	History which is comprised of special source funds collected by or
15	otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of
16	defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal year
17	beginning July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017
18	\$ 23,965,456.00.

19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
20	this act, the following positions are authorized:
21	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
22	Permanent: Full Time 133
23	Part Time 4
24	Time-Limited: Full Time 8
25	Part Time 0
26	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
27	responsibility to make certain that funds required to be
28	appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2018 do not
29	exceed Fiscal Year 2017 funds appropriated for that purpose,
30	unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year
31	2017 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data
32	provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel
33	Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to
34	fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the
35	provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the
36	agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases
37	this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2017
38	appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the
39	exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at
40	the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
41	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
42	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
43	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2017 "Personal Services"

- 44 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 45 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 46 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 47 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 49 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 50 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 51 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 52 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 53 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 54 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 55 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 56 appropriated level.
- 57 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 58 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 59 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 60 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 62 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating
- 63 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 64 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 65 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 66 Department of Archives and History shall maintain complete
- 67 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 68 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be

- 69 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
- 70 Year 2016. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- 71 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2018 shall be
- 72 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 73 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 74 provided during the Fiscal Year 2017 budget request process.
- 75 **SECTION 5.** It is the intent of the Legislature that the
- 76 Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the
- 77 maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with
- 78 the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these
- 79 charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the
- 80 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of
- 81 Archives and History.
- 82 **SECTION 6.** It is the intent of the Legislature that no part
- 83 of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for
- 84 the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State
- 85 Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.
- 86 **SECTION 7.** Of the funds provided in Section 2, Two Million
- 87 Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) is provided to the Department of Archives
- 88 and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as created in
- 89 House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help support the
- 90 preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties.
- 91 **SECTION 8.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of
- 92 this act, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is provided
- 93 for the purpose of capital development and maintenance of Beauvoir

94	Shrine,	the	last	home	of	Jefferson	Davis,	the	only	President	01	_
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- 95 the Confederate States of America, subject to approval by the
- 96 Department of Archives and History. The expenditure of funds
- 97 available in this section shall be subject to prior approval by
- 98 the Department of Archives and History.
- 99 **SECTION 9.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 100 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 101 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 102 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 103 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 104 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 105 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 106 made without competitive bids.
- 107 **SECTION 10.** In addition to all other sums herein
- 108 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 109 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
- 110 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Archives and
- 111 History for the purpose of supporting the Statewide Oral History
- 112 Project for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, and ending
- 113 June 30, 2017.....\$ 50,000.00.
- 114 **SECTION 11.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 115 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 116 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 117 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 118 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally

- 119 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 120 actions contrary to this provision.
- 121 **SECTION 12.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2,
- 122 Fifty-one Thousand Dollars (\$51,000.00) from the Historic
- 123 Properties Trust Fund is provided for the study of expanding areas
- 124 of Vicksburg National Military Park.
- 125 **SECTION 13.** Of the funds provided in Section 2, Seven
- 126 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) is provided from
- 127 Special Funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the State
- 128 Treasury fund created in Section 27-19-56.69(8), Mississippi Code
- 129 of 1972, for the purpose of paying the costs of repair and
- 130 renovation of the New Capitol, the Old Capitol, the Governor's
- 131 Mansion, and the War Memorial Building, in accordance with rules
- 132 and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in
- 133 a manner consistent with the escalation of funds.
- 134 **SECTION 14.** The amount of funds appropriated from the State
- 135 General Fund in this bill are conditioned upon the availability
- 136 for appropriation of the full amount of the state general funds
- 137 that were projected in the general fund revenue estimate for
- 138 fiscal year 2017 that was determined under the provision of
- 139 Section 27-103-125.
- 140 If the amount of general funds projected to be available for
- 141 appropriation for fiscal year 2017 would be reduced by the
- 142 enactment into law of any revenue bills, as defined in Joint Rule
- 143 40, that have been passed by the House of Representatives by March

144	1/, 2016, then the amount of funds appropriated from the State
145	General Fund in this bill shall be reduced by the same percentage
146	reduction in the amount of general funds that would be available
147	for appropriation for fiscal year 2017, and the reduced amount
148	shall be engrossed into this bill before it is transmitted to
149	Senate.
150	The determination of whether the House has passed any such
151	revenue bills by March 17, 2016, and the amount and percentage of
152	the resulting reduction in the amount of general funds projected
153	to be available for appropriation for fiscal year 2017, shall be
154	determined by the Legislative Budget Office and certified in
155	writing to the Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee by
156	the Director of the Legislative Budget Office.
157	SECTION 15. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
158	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
159	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
160	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
161	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
162	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
