HOUSE BILL NO. 1649

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER 2 PARKWAY COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF 3 THE COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 7 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi River Parkway Commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 8 commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, and ending 9 June 30, 2017.....\$ 10 21,855.00. 11 SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi River Parkway Commission shall maintain complete 12 13 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 14 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 15 16 Year 2016. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2018 shall be 17 18 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format

21 It is the intention of the Legislature that SECTION 3. 22 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 23 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 24 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 25 26 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 27 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 28 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for actions contrary to this provision.

36 SECTION 5. The amount of funds appropriated from the State 37 General Fund in this bill are conditioned upon the availability 38 for appropriation of the full amount of the state general funds 39 that were projected in the general fund revenue estimate for 40 fiscal year 2017 that was determined under the provision of 41 Section 27-103-125.

If the amount of general funds projected to be available for appropriation for fiscal year 2017 would be reduced by the

No. 1649 ~ OFFICIAL ~ 16/HR13/A487 PAGE 2 (RM\DW) 44 enactment into law of any revenue bills, as defined in Joint Rule 45 40, that have been passed by the House of Representatives by March 17, 2016, then the amount of funds appropriated from the State 46 General Fund in this bill shall be reduced by the same percentage 47 48 reduction in the amount of general funds that would be available 49 for appropriation for fiscal year 2017, and the reduced amount shall be engrossed into this bill before it is transmitted to 50 51 Senate.

52 The determination of whether the House has passed any such 53 revenue bills by March 17, 2016, and the amount and percentage of 54 the resulting reduction in the amount of general funds projected 55 to be available for appropriation for fiscal year 2017, shall be 56 determined by the Legislative Budget Office and certified in 57 writing to the Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee by 58 the Director of the Legislative Budget Office.

59 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 60 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 61 62 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 63 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 64 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 65 and after July 1, 2016; and shall stand repealed from and after 66

67 June 30, 2016.

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
