5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
8	Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance
9	of the State Forestry Commission for the fiscal year beginning
10	July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017
11	\$ 18,438,508.00.
12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in
14	the State Treasury to the credit of the State Forestry Commission
15	which is comprised of special source funds collected by or
16	otherwise available to the commission, for the support and
17	maintenance of the commission for the fiscal year beginning
18	July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017

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20	Of the funds specified in this section, Two Hundred Fifty
21	Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be deposited in a fund
22	created in the State Treasury called the "Forest Improvement

124	SECTION 6. There is created in the State Treasury a fund
125	designated as the Volunteer Fire Department Equipment Conversion
126	Revolving Fund to be used by the State Forestry Commission to
127	assist in the conversion of vehicles acquired by the State
128	Forestry Commission through the Federal Excess Personal Property
129	Program or by volunteer fire departments through other means to
130	adapt them for use in the suppression of wildland fires. This
131	assistance shall be in the form of fabrication of water tanks or
132	other accessories necessary for the operation of fire suppression
133	units, installation of piping and valves, painting or other
134	similar or associated component work necessary to place fire
135	suppression equipment into service. It is not for general vehicle
136	maintenance or repair.
137	The Volunteer Fire Department Equipment Conversion Revolving
138	Fund shall be funded by monies received from charges for work and
139	services performed for volunteer fire departments by the State
140	Forestry Commission. Monies collected from such charges shall be
141	deposited into the Volunteer Fire Department Equipment Conversion
142	Revolving Fund. The State Treasurer shall make disbursements
143	therefrom for payment of materials, supplies and labor upon

146	The amount of monies deposited into the Volunteer Fire
147	Department Equipment Conversion Fund through this work shall not
148	exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00). Funds in excess of

150	Forestry Commission's regular appropriated special funds. Monies
151	in this revolving fund are to be considered special funds and
152	shall be carried forward from one fiscal year to the next.
153	SECTION 7. There is created in the State Treasury a fund
154	designated as the Camden State Forest Revolving Fund to be used by
155	the State Forestry Commission to direct forest management
156	activities on the Camden State Forest in Madison County,
157	Mississippi. The forest management activities will include, but
158	not be limited to, maintenance of property, timber sale activities
159	and regeneration work.
160	The Camden State Forest Revolving Fund shall be funded by
161	monies received from timber sales, leases, and any other source.
162	Monies collected from these income sources shall be deposited into

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168	It is the intention of the Legislature that any revolving
169	funds in excess of the budgeted amount needed for the necessary
170	operation and maintenance of all properties under the direct
171	supervision and management of the State Forestry Commission shall
172	remain in the Camden State Forest Revolving Fund for use in future
173	years.

SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, it is the 174 175 intention of the Legislature that Two Hundred Thousand Dollars 176 (\$200,000.00) shall be transferred to the Department of 177 Agriculture and Commerce for the Beaver Control or Eradication 178 Program during the Fiscal Year 2017.

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- SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids.
- 187 SECTION 10. Any person who was an employee of the Forestry 188 Commission who was laid off during Fiscal Year 2006 shall be given 189 first priority in any new employment by the commission.
- 190 SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 191 192 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency

193	shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
194	appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
195	or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
196	actions contrary to this provision.

SECTION 12. The amount of funds appropriated from the State
General Fund in this bill are conditioned upon the availability
for appropriation of the full amount of the state general funds
that were projected in the general fund revenue estimate for
fiscal year 2017 that was determined under the provision of
Section 27-103-125.

If the amount of general funds projected to be available for appropriation for fiscal year 2017 would be reduced by the enactment into law of any revenue bills, as defined in Joint Rule 40, that have been passed by the House of Representatives by March 17, 2016, then the amount of funds appropriated from the State General Fund in this bill shall be reduced by the same percentage reduction in the amount of general funds that would be available for appropriation for fiscal year 2017, and the reduced amount shall be engrossed into this bill before it is transmitted to Senate.

The determination of whether the House has passed any such revenue bills by March 17, 2016, and the amount and percentage of the resulting reduction in the amount of general funds projected to be available for appropriation for fiscal year 2017, shall be determined by the Legislative Budget Office and certified in

220	SECTION 13. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
221	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
222	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
223	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
224	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
225	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law

226 **SECTION 14.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 227 and after July 1, 2016; and shall stand repealed from and after 228 June 30, 2016.
