HOUSE BILL NO. 1658

1 AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 2 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE TOMBIGBEE RIVER VALLEY 3 WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is authorized and approved for expenditure out of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available to the 7 8 Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District, for the purpose 9 of paying bond maturities, accrued interest, maintenance expenses, project development costs, and any other authorized expenses of 10 11 the water management district, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017..... 12 13\$ 7,842,976.00. 14 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 15 Section 1, the following positions are authorized: 16 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: Permanent: Full Time..... 17 16 18 Part Time.... 0 ~ OFFICIAL ~ A1/2H. With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 21 22 responsibility to make certain that funds required to be 23 appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2018 do not 24 exceed Fiscal Year 2017 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 25 26 2017 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data 27 provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to 28 29 fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the 30 provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 31 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 32 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2017 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the 33 34 exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at 35 the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 36 37 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2017 "Personal Services" 38 39 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 40 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 41 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 42

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43 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 44 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 45 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 46 47 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 48 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 49 50 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 51 appropriated level.

52 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 53 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 54 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 55 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

60 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 61 Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District shall maintain 62 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 63 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 64 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2016. It is further the intention of 65 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 66 67 2018 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee

71 It is the intention of the Legislature that SECTION 4. 72 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 73 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 74 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 75 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 76 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 77 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 78 made without competitive bids.

79 SECTION 5. All monies in possession of the district in 80 excess of necessary operating funds shall be deposited with a bank 81 or banks selected by the board of directors of the district. 82 These funds shall be deposited in such bank or banks and in such 83 manner that interest earned shall be at least equal to interest 84 earnings on state funds deposited by the State Treasury.

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for actions contrary to this provision.

95 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 96 and after July 1, 2016; and shall stand repealed from and after 97 June 30, 2016.
