1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING MR. - 23 Mississippi Cattlemen's Association, President of the National
- 24 Cotton Ginners Association and Vice President of the Delta
- 25 Council; and
- 26 WHEREAS, through his many years of service, Mr. Taylor
- 27 cultivated the skill and experience to lead his profession
- 28 forward, currently serving as: Chairman of the National Cotton
- 29 Council, member of the USDA's Agriculture Technical Committee for
- 30 Trade, Commissioner for the Panola County Soil and Water
- 31 Conservation District, Commissioner of the Panola-Tate Drainage
- 32 District, board member for Delta Wildlife and Chairman of the
- 33 Panola County Land Planning Commission, of which he was a founding
- 34 member; and
- 35 WHEREAS, Mr. Taylor has also been recognized for his many
- 36 contributions to agriculture: he has been featured in numerous
- 37 trade publications and magazines, including Cotton Farming
- 38 Magazine and Cotton Grower Magazine and Mississippi State College
- 39 of Agriculture and Life Sciences Magazine, as a leader in
- 40 agriculture; he has also received the 2015 McCallie Alumni
- 41 Achievement Award, along with being recognized as Mississippi
- 42 Cattleman of the Year and Mississippi Farmer of the Year; and
