HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 73

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE EXCEPTIONAL AND

26 building project; he also enjoys reading the Bible and listening  
27 to gospel music; and

29 community, Mr. Glover looks forward to spending more irreplaceable  
30 quality time with his wife, sons and grandchildren and playing  
31 golf, hunting and fishing; and

33 the unparalleled commitment and professionalism of individuals of  
34 exceptional caliber, such as Mr. Glover, whose hard work and  
35 commitment to public service has been of great benefit to the  
36 State of Mississippi and all of those he has selflessly served:
