HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 77

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING MR.
2 TAVEZE CALHOUN UPON RECEIVING THE DISTINCT HONOR OF BEING NAMED A
3 WILLIAM V. CAMPBELL TROPHY FINALIST.

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2015, Mr. Taveze Calhoun was honored

5 by the National Football Foundation in New York City as one of 12

6 finalists for the William V. Campbell Trophy, also known as the

7 "Academic Heisman Trophy"; and

8 WHEREAS, the 12 finalists were chosen from a well-vetted pool

9 of 135 total candidates, each of whom represented the best senior

10 student athlete on their respective teams, playing in their final

11 year of eligibility and either starting for their team or making

12 significant contributions for their team; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Calhoun's journey to New York City began in

14 Morton, Mississippi, his hometown, where he played football for

15 the Morton High School Panthers, the program that began to develop

16 the skill of a talented football player on Friday nights, while

17 excelling in the classroom where he acquired a passion for

18 academics, especially for history classes; and

19	WHEREAS, after high school Mr. Calhoun chose to attend
20	Mississippi State University to further quench his thirst for
21	academics and to play football in the Southeastern Conference; and
22	WHEREAS, over the course of his college football career, Mr.
23	Calhoun continued to prove his unrivaled commitment to excellence,
24	as evidenced by the hours spent practicing, studying game film and
25	meeting with positional coaches, an approach that undoubtedly
26	proved to be a formula for success while attending Mississippi
27	State, where he played in 45 games, started 31 games and was
28	chosen to lead the team as a 2015 team captain, a fitting
29	recognition for his many years of hard work and leadership; and
30	WHEREAS, prior to being selected as a William V. Campbell
31	Trophy Finalist, Mr. Calhoun has earned distinction as a
32	Southeastern Conference Academic Honor Roll member three times,
33	additionally, he serves his community and the State of Mississippi
34	by volunteering with the Salvation Army, the Starkville Manor
35	Nursing Home, the Oktibbeha County Humane Society, Deuce
36	McAllister's Catch 22 Foundation and aided in efforts to provide
37	tornado relief for the people of Louisville, Mississippi; and
38	WHEREAS, in addition to playing football and serving his
39	community, Mr. Calhoun also continued his passion for education,
40	earning his undergraduate degree in interdisciplinary studies, and
41	immediately began and is currently working toward a graduate
42	degree in workforce leadership while planning for his future after
43	the National Football League; and

- WHEREAS, as the fourth Mississippi State University football
- 45 player to be selected as a National Football Foundation National
- 46 Scholar-Athlete in the program's history, Mr. Calhoun will receive
- 47 a post-graduate scholarship for \$18,000.00 and the incalculable
- 48 honor of representing his school in receiving one of the highest
- 49 honors a student athlete can aspire for; and
- 50 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to share in the
- 51 enthusiasm of citizens of this state as they represent Mississippi
- 52 through outstanding achievements and honors, such as Mr. Calhoun,
- 53 who has brought honor to his university, his hometown and to the
- 54 State of Mississippi:
- 55 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
- 56 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
- 57 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Mr. Taveze
- 58 Calhoun upon being named a 2015 William V. Campbell Trophy
- 59 Finalist, and extend best wishes for success in all of his future
- 60 endeavors.
