SENATE BILL NO. 2026

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 73-15-5 AND 73-15-20, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT ADVANCED PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSES SHALL HAVE FULL PRACTICE AUTHORITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 73-15-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 73-15-5. (1) "Board" means the Mississippi Board of
- 8 Nursing.
- 9 (2) The "practice of nursing" by a registered nurse means
- 10 the performance for compensation of services which requires
- 11 substantial knowledge of the biological, physical, behavioral,
- 12 psychological and sociological sciences and of nursing theory as
- 13 the basis for assessment, diagnosis, planning, intervention and
- 14 evaluation in the promotion and maintenance of health; management
- 15 of individuals' responses to illness, injury or infirmity; the
- 16 restoration of optimum function; or the achievement of a dignified
- 17 death. "Nursing practice" includes, but is not limited to,
- 18 administration, teaching, counseling, delegation and supervision

- 19 of nursing, and execution of the medical regimen, including the
- 20 administration of medications and treatments prescribed by any
- 21 licensed or legally authorized physician or dentist. The
- 22 foregoing shall not be deemed to include acts of medical diagnosis
- 23 or prescriptions of medical, therapeutic or corrective measures,
- 24 except as may be set forth by rules and regulations promulgated
- 25 and implemented by the Mississippi Board of Nursing.
- 26 (3) "Clinical nurse specialist practice" by a certified
- 27 clinical nurse specialist means the delivery of advanced practice
- 28 nursing care to individuals or groups using advanced diagnostic
- 29 and assessment skills to manage and improve the health status of
- 30 individuals and families; diagnose human responses to actual or
- 31 potential health problems; plan for health promotion, disease
- 32 prevention, and therapeutic intervention in collaboration with the
- 33 patient or client; implement therapeutic interventions based on
- 34 the nurse specialist's area of expertise and within the scope of
- 35 advanced nursing practice, including, but not limited to, direct
- 36 patient care, counseling, teaching, collaboration with other
- 37 licensed health care providers; and, coordination of health care
- 38 as necessary and appropriate and evaluation of the effectiveness
- 39 of care.
- 40 (4) "Advanced nursing practice" means, in addition to the
- 41 practice of professional nursing, the performance of
- 42 advanced-level nursing approved by the board which, by virtue of
- 43 graduate education and experience are appropriately performed by

- 44 an advanced practice registered nurse. The advanced practice
- 45 registered nurse may diagnose, treat and manage medical
- 46 conditions. This may include prescriptive authority as identified
- 47 by the board. * * *
- 48 (5) The "practice of nursing" by a licensed practical nurse
- 49 means the performance for compensation of services requiring basic
- 50 knowledge of the biological, physical, behavioral, psychological
- 51 and sociological sciences and of nursing procedures which do not
- 52 require the substantial skill, judgment and knowledge required of
- 53 a registered nurse. These services are performed under the
- 54 direction of a registered nurse or a licensed physician or
- 55 licensed dentist and utilize standardized procedures in the
- 56 observation and care of the ill, injured and infirm; in the
- 57 maintenance of health; in action to safeguard life and health; and
- 58 in the administration of medications and treatments prescribed by
- 59 any licensed physician or licensed dentist authorized by state law
- 60 to prescribe. On a selected basis, and within safe limits, the
- 61 role of the licensed practical nurse shall be expanded by the
- 62 board under its rule-making authority to more complex procedures
- 63 and settings commensurate with additional preparation and
- 64 experience.
- 65 (6) A "license" means an authorization to practice nursing
- 66 as a registered nurse or a licensed practical nurse designated
- 67 herein.

- 68 A "registered nurse" is a person who is licensed or 69 holds the privilege to practice under the provisions of this 70 article and who practices nursing as defined herein. "RN" is the 71 abbreviation for the title of Registered Nurse.
- 72 A "licensed practical nurse" is a person who is licensed 73 or holds the privilege to practice under this article and who 74 practices practical nursing as defined herein. "LPN" is the abbreviation for the title of Licensed Practical Nurse. 75
- 76 (9) A "registered nurse in clinical practice" is one who 77 functions in any health care delivery system which provides 78 nursing services.
- (10) A "clinical nurse specialist" is a person who is 79 80 licensed or holds the privilege to practice under this article in this state to practice professional nursing and who in this state 81 practices advanced nursing as defined herein. "CNS" is the 82 83 abbreviation for the title of Clinical Nurse Specialist.
- (11) An "advanced practice registered nurse" is a person who is licensed or holds the privilege to practice under this article 85 86 and who is certified in advanced practice registered nurse or 87 specialized nursing practice and includes certified registered nurse midwives, certified registered nurse anesthetists and 88 89 certified nurse practitioners. "CNM" is the abbreviation for the 90 title of Certified Nurse Midwife, "CRNA" is the abbreviation for 91 the title of Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist. "CNP" is the abbreviation for the title of Certified Nurse Practitioner. 92

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93	(12) A "nurse educator" is a registered nurse who meets the
94	criteria for faculty as set forth in a state-accredited program of
95	nursing for registered nurses, or a state-approved program of
96	nursing for licensed practical nurses, and who functions as a
97	faculty member.

- 98 (13) A "consumer representative" is a person representing the interests of the general public, who may use services of a 99 100 health agency or health professional organization or its members 101 but who is neither a provider of health services, nor employed in 102 the health services field, nor holds a vested interest in the 103 provision of health services at any level, nor has an immediate 104 family member who holds vested interests in the provision of 105 health services at any level.
- 106 (14) "Privilege to practice" means the authorization to
 107 practice nursing in the state as described in the Nurse Licensure
 108 Compact provided for in Section 73-15-22.
- 109 (15) "Licensee" is a person who has been issued a license to
 110 practice nursing in the state or who holds the privilege to
 111 practice nursing in the state.
- SECTION 2. Section 73-15-20, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:
- 73-15-20. (1) Advanced practice registered nurses. Any
 nurse desiring to be certified as an advanced practice registered
 nurse shall apply to the board and submit proof that he or she

117 holds a current license to practice professional nursing and t	:hat
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- 118 he or she meets one or more of the following requirements:
- 119 (a) Satisfactory completion of a formal post-basic
- 120 educational program of at least one (1) academic year, the primary
- 121 purpose of which is to prepare nurses for advanced or specialized
- 122 practice.
- 123 (b) Certification by a board-approved certifying body.
- 124 Such certification shall be required for initial state
- 125 certification and any recertification as a registered nurse
- 126 anesthetist, nurse practitioner or nurse midwife. The board may
- 127 by rule provide for provisional or temporary state certification
- 128 of graduate nurse practitioners for a period of time determined to
- 129 be appropriate for preparing and passing the National
- 130 Certification Examination. Those with provisional or temporary
- 131 certifications must practice under the direct supervision of a
- 132 licensed physician or a certified nurse practitioner or certified
- 133 nurse midwife with at least five (5) years of experience.
- 134 (c) Graduation from a program leading to a master's or
- 135 post-master's degree in a nursing clinical specialty area with
- 136 preparation in specialized practitioner skills.
- 137 (2) Rulemaking. The board shall provide by rule the
- 138 appropriate requirements for advanced practice registered nurses
- 139 in the categories of certified registered nurse anesthetist,
- 140 certified nurse midwife and advanced practice registered nurse.
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142 (** $\frac{*}{3}$) Renewal. The board shall renew a license for an

143 advanced practice registered nurse upon receipt of the renewal

144 application, fees and protocol or practice guidelines. The board

145 shall adopt rules establishing procedures for license renewals.

146 The board shall by rule prescribe continuing education

147 requirements for advanced practice nurses not to exceed forty (40)

148 hours biennially as a condition for renewal of a license or

149 certificate.

150 (* * *4) Reinstatement. Advanced practice registered

151 nurses may reinstate a lapsed privilege to practice upon

152 submitting documentation of a current active license to practice

professional nursing, a reinstatement application and fee, * * *

154 documentation of current certification as an advanced practice

155 nurse in a designated area of practice by a national certification

156 organization recognized by the board and documentation of at least

157 forty (40) hours of continuing education related to the advanced

158 clinical practice of the nurse practitioner within the previous

two-year period. The board shall adopt rules establishing the

160 procedure for reinstatement.

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162 (* * *5) Practice requirements. The advanced practice

163 registered nurse shall practice:

164 (a) According to standards and guidelines of the

165 National Certification Organization.

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167		(* * * <u>b</u>)	According	to	а	board-approved	protocol	or
168	practice	quidelines.						

(* * *<u>c</u>) Advanced practice registered nurses

practicing as nurse anesthetists must practice according to

board-approved practice guidelines that address pre-anesthesia

preparation and evaluation; anesthesia induction, maintenance, and

emergence; post-anesthesia care; peri-anesthetic and clinical

support functions.

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(* * *<u>d</u>) Nurse practitioners may not write

prescriptions for, dispense or order the use of or administration

of any schedule of controlled substances except as contained in

this chapter.

(***6) Prescribing controlled substances and medications.

Certified nurse midwives * * *, certified nurse practitioners and certified registered nurse anesthetists may apply for controlled substance prescriptive authority after completing a board-approved educational program. Certified nurse midwives * * *, certified nurse practitioners and certified registered nurse anesthetists who have completed the program and received prescription authority from the board may prescribe Schedules II-V. The words "administer," "controlled substances" and "ultimate user," shall have the same meaning as set forth in Section 41-29-105, unless the context otherwise requires. The board shall promulgate rules governing prescribing of controlled substances, including

192	distribution, record keeping, drug maintenance, labeling and
193	distribution requirements and prescription guidelines for
194	controlled substances and all medications. Prescribing any
195	controlled substance in violation of the rules promulgated by the
196	board shall constitute a violation of Section 73-15-29(1)(f), (k)
197	and (1) and shall be grounds for disciplinary action. The
198	prescribing, administering or distributing of any legend drug or
199	other medication in violation of the rules promulgated by the
200	board shall constitute a violation of Section 73-15-29(1)(f), (k)
201	and (1) and shall be grounds for disciplinary action.
202	SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
203	and after July 1, 2016.
