SENATE BILL NO. 2951

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WAYNE COUNTY,
2 MISSISSIPPI, TO LEVY AN ASSESSMENT, IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER
3 ASSESSMENTS AND COURT COSTS, FOR CIVIL CASES FILED AND MISDEMEANOR
4 CONVICTIONS IN ITS JUSTICE COURT TO BE USED TO FUND THE
5 CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A NEW COUNTY OFFICE
6 BUILDING TO BE KNOWN AS THE "WAYNE COUNTY JUSTICE COMPLEX"; AND
7 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

9 **SECTION 1.** (1) The Board of Supervisors of Wayne County,
10 Mississippi, in its discretion, is authorized, by resolution duly
11 adopted, to levy an assessment, in addition to any other
12 assessments and court costs in the Justice Court of Wayne County
13 as follows:

14 (a) An amount not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for
15 each conviction or nonadjudication under the Mississippi Implied
16 Consent Law; and

17 (b) An amount not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars
18 (\$25.00) on each misdemeanor conviction other than those specified
19 in paragraph (a) of this subsection or each civil case filed.



20 (2) The avails of the additional assessment imposed under
21 subsection (1) of this section shall be expended by the Board of
22 Supervisors of Wayne County to fund the construction, operation,
23 maintenance and related needs of a new county office building, to
24 be known as the "Wayne County Justice Complex."

25 (3) This section shall be repealed from and after July 1,
26 2020.

27 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
28 and after its passage.
