SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 540

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING 2 RENOWNED CLAY CRAFTSMAN CLAUDIA CARTEE UPON HER RECEIPT OF THE 3 2016 GOVERNOR'S ARTS AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN VISUAL ARTS. 4 WHEREAS, Claudia Cartee has worked as a professional Studio Potter since 1973; and 5 WHEREAS, she was born into a family of artists. Her mother 6 was a Visual Artist and her father was a Musician and Master Mold 7 8 Maker. He was the one to set Claudia on her journey in clay by 9 purchasing a potter's wheel for her. She began her formal college-level studies in pottery and received her degree at 10 11 California State University; and

12 WHEREAS, in 1978, she was asked to join the Craftsmen's Guild 13 of Mississippi. She was one of only a few female artists who 14 worked with clay on a wheel. She has been a Guild Fellow since 15 1987. Ms. Cartee has served as President of the Guild and on the 16 Board of Directors and has shown her work for decades at the 17 popular Chimneyville Crafts Festival; and

A year after studying at Penland, 21 she was awarded the Mississippi Arts Commission's Artist 22 Fellowship Award. She received the honor again in 2012; and

23 WHEREAS, among her clay sculptures and wall pieces, Ms. 24 Cartee's usable pottery and functional works are very popular with 25 collectors. She signs her work "Ka", which means the part of the 26 spirit that lives on after death; and

27 WHEREAS, she has received numerous awards from juried shows 28 and festivals throughout Mississippi and the region. Her gallery 29 and museum exhibitions range from the Meridian Museum of Art to 30 the Attic Gallery in Vicksburg, the University of Southern 31 Mississippi's Museum of Art, and the Mississippi Museum of Art, 32 among many others. Her work resides in permanent collections 33 throughout Mississippi; and

34 WHEREAS, Ms. Cartee's exceptional success as a Potter from rural Mississippi has cultivated arts tourism in Seminary, 35 36 Mississippi, where her studio and sales gallery are located; and 37 WHEREAS, Claudia Cartee has shared her love of creating 38 pottery by teaching throughout her career, mentoring clay artists 39 and conducting countless workshops to help the next generation of 40 potters; and it is with great pride that we recognize a Mississippi artist whose record of achievement has brought honor 41 42 to her community and to the State of Mississippi:
