SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 580

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND CONGRATULATING THE 2 ALCORN STATE UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF EDUCATION AND PSYCHOLOGY FOR 3 MEETING THE NEW COUNCIL FOR THE ACCREDITATION OF EDUCATOR 4 PREPARATION (CAEP) ACCREDITATION STANDARDS. 5 WHEREAS, the National Council for Accreditation of Teacher 6 Education (NCATE) was founded as a nonprofit, nongovernmental 7 accrediting body for teacher preparation programs in 1954; and 8 WHEREAS, the Teacher Education Accreditation Council (TEAC), dedicated to improving academic degree programs for professional 9 10 educators who teach and lead in schools Pre-K through Grade 12, was founded in 1997; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the Boards of NCATE and TEAC accepted the formation 13 of a new accrediting body, the Council for the Accreditation of 14 Educator Preparation (CAEP), in 2010; and WHEREAS, the Council for the Accreditation of Educator 15 16 Preparation (CAEP) Commission on Standards and Performance 17 Reporting convened in 2012 to develop the next generation of 18 accreditation standards and performance measures for educator

25 WHEREAS, CAEP accreditation standards were fully implemented; 26 NCATE and TEAC legacy standards are no longer used for 27 accreditation in 2016; and

28 WHEREAS, Alcorn State University School of Education and 29 Psychology met the new rigorous professional standards for the 30 preparation of teachers and other school specialists on October 31 27, 2015, becoming nationally accredited by CAEP; and

32 WHEREAS, Alcorn State University School of Education and 33 Psychology is pioneer in leading the way by becoming the first of 34 Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) in the nation 35 and the first institution of higher learning (IHL) in the State of 36 Mississippi to achieve this accreditation; and this achievement 37 was made possible by the collaborative efforts of administrators, 38 colleagues, community, students and supporters:

39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF 40 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That 41 we do hereby recognize and congratulate the Alcorn State 42 University School of Education and Psychology for meeting the new 43 Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP) 44 accreditation standards, and extend the best wishes of the
