HOUSE BILL NO. 31

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE OWNER OF AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE TO
REGISTER THE VEHICLE WITH THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT OF THE COUNTY
OF HIS OR HER RESIDENCE; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
SAFETY TO ESTABLISH A STATEWIDE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE REGISTRATION
NETWORK DESIGNED TO PROVIDE IMMEDIATE RESPONSE TO SHERIFFS'
DEPARTMENTS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES WITH REGARD TO REPORTS OR
COMPLAINTS INVOLVING ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES; TO PROVIDE FOR THE
COLLECTION AND DISPOSITION OF FEES FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE
OF THE NETWORK; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 11 **SECTION 1.** (1) The term "all-terrain vehicle" or "ATV," as
- 12 used in this section, means any motorized vehicle manufactured and
- 13 designed exclusively for off-road use that is fifty (50) inches or
- 14 less in width, has an unladen dry weight of seven hundred fifty
- 15 (750) pounds or less, travels on three (3), four (4) or more low
- 16 pressure tires, has a seat designed to be straddled by the
- 17 operator and uses handlebars for steering control.
- 18 (2) Beginning July 1, 2017, every owner of an all-terrain
- 19 vehicle who is a resident of this state, shall register that
- 20 vehicle with the sheriff of the county in which the owner resides.
- 21 Registration shall be made in duplicate on a form prepared and

- 22 provided to the sheriff by the Mississippi Department of Public
- 23 Safety. Each form shall include: (a) the name and address of the
- 24 owner of the vehicle; (b) the age and sex of the owner; (c) the
- 25 make, model and serial number of the vehicle; (d) the name and
- 26 address of the person, firm or business from whom the vehicle was
- 27 acquired or purchased and the date of acquisition or purchase; and
- 28 (e) the place where the vehicle is usually kept.
- 29 (3) The original registration form shall be retained by the
- 30 sheriff in a safe and convenient file to be furnished him by the
- 31 board of supervisors for that purpose and also may be recorded on
- 32 computer or other electronic format. All registrations shall be
- 33 filed and arranged and/or formatted for retrieval in alphabetical
- 34 order and shall be open to public inspection as required under the
- 35 Mississippi Public Records Act of 1983. A copy of the
- 36 registration form shall be forwarded to the Department of Public
- 37 Safety within thirty (30) days after completion of registration.
- 38 The department shall file and maintain copies of all registrations
- 39 filed with it and shall establish and maintain a statewide ATV
- 40 registration network designed to provide immediate response to
- 41 sheriffs' departments and other law enforcement agencies with
- 42 regard to reports or complaints involving ATVs. At the time of
- 43 registration, the sheriff shall issue to the registrant a decal
- 44 for placement on the ATV. The decal shall be designed by the
- 45 Department of Public Safety and shall be provided to the sheriff
- 46 by the department. Each decal shall contain a number and/or other

- 47 vehicle identifying information as the Department of Public Safety
- 48 may prescribe so that the decal may be identified from a
- 49 reasonable distance.
- 50 (4) At the time of registration, the registrant shall pay to
- 51 the sheriff a one-time fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00). Six Dollars
- 52 (\$6.00) of the fee shall be forwarded to the Department of Public
- 53 Safety at the time that the sheriff's department is required under
- 54 subsection (3) of this section to provide the department with a
- 55 copy of the registration. Four Dollars (\$4.00) of the fee shall
- 56 be retained by the sheriff and shall be paid to the chancery clerk
- 57 for deposit into the general fund of the county. The fees
- 58 received by the Department of Public Safety shall be deposited
- 59 into the Department of Public Safety Administrative Fund created
- 45 under Section 45-1-21 and may be expended by the department, upon
- 61 appropriation by the Legislature, for the expenses the department
- 62 incurs in complying with the provisions of this section.
- 63 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 64 and after July 1, 2017.
