HOUSE BILL NO. 390

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 21-35-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 INCREASE FROM 1,500 TO 2,000 THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF RESIDENTS THAT A MUNICIPALITY MUST HAVE BEFORE A MUNICIPALITY IS REQUIRED TO 3 4 PUBLISH ITS ANNUAL BUDGET; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 21-35-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 8 21-35-5. The governing authorities of each municipality of 9 the State of Mississippi shall, not later than September 15 each 10 year, prepare a complete budget of the municipal revenues, expenses and working cash balances estimated for the next fiscal 11 12 year, and shall prepare a statement showing the aggregate revenues 13 collected during the current year in \* \* \* the municipality for 14 municipal purposes. \* \* \* The statement shall show every source of revenue along with the amount derived from each source. \* \* \* 15 The budget of any municipality of **\* \* \*** two thousand (2,000) 16 17 inhabitants or more, according to the \* \* \* latest federal decennial census, with \* \* \* the statement of revenue and 18 19 expenses, shall be published at least one (1) time during H. 20 September of **\* \* \*** the year in a newspaper published in such 21 municipality or, if no newspaper be published in such 22 municipality, in any newspaper published in the county wherein the 23 municipality is located. In municipalities of less than \* \* \* two 24 thousand (2,000) inhabitants, according to the last preceding 25 federal census, as many as three (3) prepared statements of \* \* \* the budget shall be posted in three (3) public places in \* \* \* the 26 27 municipalities.

28 **\* \* \*** Before the adoption of a budget pursuant to this 29 section, the governing authority of each municipality shall hold 30 at least one (1) public hearing to provide the general public with 31 an opportunity to comment on the taxing and spending plan 32 incorporated in the proposed budget. The public hearing shall be held at least one (1) week prior to the adoption of the budget 33 with advance notice and held outside normal working hours. 34 The 35 advance notice shall include an announcement published or posted 36 in the same manner as required for the final adopted budget.

37 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 38 and after July 1, 2017.
