HOUSE BILL NO. 614

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT NO PUBLIC FUNDS OF THIS STATE, OR ANY 2 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE, SHALL BE ALLOCATED TO THE IMPLEMENTATION, REGULATION, OR ENFORCEMENT OF ANY FEDERAL LAW, 4 EXECUTIVE ORDER, RULE, OR REGULATION REGULATING THE OWNERSHIP, 5 USE, OR POSSESSION OF FIREARMS, AMMUNITION, OR FIREARM ACCESSORIES, IF THE EXPENDITURE OF PUBLIC FUNDS WOULD RESULT IN THE VIOLATION OF ANOTHER MISSISSIPPI STATUTE OR COMMON LAW, OR THE MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION; TO PROVIDE THAT NO PERSONNEL OR PROPERTY OF THIS STATE, OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE, SHALL 9 10 BE ALLOCATED TO THE IMPLEMENTATION, REGULATION, OR ENFORCEMENT OF ANY FEDERAL LAW, EXECUTIVE ORDER, RULE, OR REGULATION REGULATING 11 12 THE OWNERSHIP, USE, OR POSSESSION OF FIREARMS, AMMUNITION, OR FIREARM ACCESSORIES, IF THE USE OF PERSONNEL OR PROPERTY WOULD 13 14 RESULT IN THE VIOLATION OF ANOTHER MISSISSIPPI STATUTE OR COMMON 15 LAW, OR THE MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** (1) On or after July 1, 2017, no public funds of 17 18 this state, or any political subdivision of this state, shall be allocated to the implementation, regulation, or enforcement of any 19 20 federal law, executive order, rule, or regulation regulating the 21 ownership, use, or possession of firearms, ammunition, or firearm 22 accessories, if the expenditure of public funds would result in the violation of another Mississippi statute or common law, or the 23 24 Mississippi Constitution.

25	(2) On or after July 1, 2017, no personnel or property of
26	this state, or any political subdivision of this state, shall be
27	allocated to the implementation, regulation, or enforcement of any
28	federal law, executive order, rule, or regulation regulating the
29	ownership, use, or possession of firearms, ammunition, or firearm
30	accessories, if the use of personnel or property would result in
31	the violation of another Mississippi statute or common law, or the
32	Mississippi Constitution.

33 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 34 and after July 1, 2017.
