## HOUSE BILL NO. 626

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT ENFORCEMENT OF CERTAIN LAWS REGARDING

2 FIREARMS, ACCESSORIES OR AMMUNITION; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR 3 STATE OFFICIALS, AGENTS OR EMPLOYEES WHO VIOLATE THIS ACT; TO PROVIDE THAT THIS ACT DOES NOT APPLY TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF FEDERAL 5 LAW FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF TRANSFERRING FIREARMS; AND FOR RELATED 6 PURPOSES. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 SECTION 1. (1) Other than compliance with an order of the 9 court, any official, agent or employee of the State of Mississippi 10 or political subdivision or agency thereof, who knowingly and willfully orders an official, agent or employee of this state, or 11 political subdivision of this state, to enforce any executive 12 13 order, agency order, law not enrolled by the United States Congress and signed by the President of the United States, rule, 14 15 regulation or administrative interpretation of a law or statute as provided in subsection (2) of this section upon a personal 16

not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), which shall be

deposited into the State General Fund; and

firearm, a firearm accessory or ammunition shall:

(a) On a first violation, be liable for a civil penalty

- 22 and, upon conviction shall be fined not more than Five Thousand
- 23 Dollars (\$5,000.00), or imprisoned for six (6) months, or both.
- Nothing in this section shall be construed to affect the law
- of search and seizure as set forth in Section 23, Article 3,
- 26 Mississippi Constitution of 1890, or as set forth in the Fourth,
- 27 Fifth and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution.
- 28 Notwithstanding anything else in this section, no private cause of
- 29 action exists under this section.
- 30 (2) Each official, agent or employee of this state or a
- 31 political subdivision of this state is prohibited from knowingly
- 32 and willfully ordering any action to enforce an executive order,
- 33 agency order, law that is not enrolled by the United States
- 34 Congress and signed by the President of the United States, or
- 35 rule, regulation or administrative interpretation of a law or
- 36 statute issued, enacted or promulgated after July 1, 2017, if such
- 37 action would be contrary to Section 12, Article 3, Mississippi
- 38 Constitution of 1890.
- 39 (3) For the purposes of this act, the term "enforcement"
- 40 does not include the performance of any act solely for the purpose
- 41 of facilitating the transfer of firearms under federal law. Any
- 42 order of enforcement not excluded by the provisions of this
- 43 subsection that occurs on and after the effective date of this act
- 44 shall be and is a breach of the oath of office of the official,

- 45 agent or employee of this state or a political subdivision of this
- 46 state.
- 47 (4) Nothing in this act shall be construed as nullifying or
- 48 overturning federal law or physically interfering with the federal
- 49 enforcement of federal law.
- 50 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 51 and after July 1, 2017.
