HOUSE BILL NO. 852

1 AN ACT TO CREATE THE "MISSISSIPPI MANDATORY IDENTIFICATION 2 ACT"; TO PROVIDE THE AUTHORIZED FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION; TO 3 PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be referred to as 7 the "Mississippi Mandatory Identification Act." 8 SECTION 2. (1) Any person who is twelve (12) years of age 9 or older shall be required to possess a form of photograph 10 identification, and shall have such identification in their possession at all times. The following forms of photograph 11 12 identification shall be acceptable: Any form of photograph identification authorized 13 (a) for voter identification under Section 23-15-563; or 14 15 (b) Any form of photograph identification from a recognized educational institution. 16 17 (2) Any person who violates the provisions of subsection (1), shall be penalized as follows: 18

No. 852 G1/2 17/HR43/R557 PAGE 1 (GT\EW) (a) First offense, shall be fined up to Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), and if such person fails to pay such fine within thirty (30) days after the court order, then, at the discretion of the judge, such person shall be ordered to perform up to ten (10) hours of community service;

(b) Second offense, shall be fined in an amount of more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), but not to exceed an amount One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00), and if such person fails to pay such fine within thirty (30) days after the court order, then, at the discretion of the judge, such person shall be ordered to perform up to twenty-five (25) hours of community service.

30 (c) Third or subsequent offense, shall be fined in an 31 amount of not less than One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00), but 32 not to exceed an amount of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00), 33 and if such person fails to pay such fine within thirty (30) days 34 after the court order, then, at the discretion of the judge, such 35 person shall be ordered to perform up to forty (40) hours of 36 community service.

37 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 38 and after July 1, 2017.
