HOUSE BILL NO. 1007

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 5-1-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE NUMBER OF REPRESENTATIVES IN THE MISSISSIPPI HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES SHALL BE REDUCED TO 99 REPRESENTATIVES BEGINNING WITH THE 2023 STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION; TO AMEND SECTION 5-1-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE NUMBER OF SENATORS IN THE MISSISSIPPI SENATE SHALL BE REDUCED TO 42 SENATORS BEGINNING WITH THE 2023 STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 5-1-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 11 amended as follows:
- 12 5-1-1. From and after the first Tuesday after the first
- 13 Monday of January 2024, the number of Representatives shall
- 14 be * * * ninety-nine (99) and shall be elected from ninety-nine
- 15 (99) districts adopted by joint resolution as provided in Section
- 16 254 of the Mississippi Constitution of 1890.
- SECTION 2. Section 5-1-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 18 amended as follows:
- 19 5-1-3. From and after the first Tuesday after the first
- 20 Monday of January 2024, the number of Senators shall be \star \star
- 21 forty-two (42) and shall be elected from \star \star \star forty-two (42)
