1 2 3 4	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-26, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS TO DEVELOP AN ELECTRONIC HARVEST REPORTING PROGRAM FOR WHITE-TAILED DEER AND WILD TURKEY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.		
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:		
6	SECTION 1. Section 49-7-26, Mississippi Code of 1972, is		
7	amended as follows:		
8	49-7-26. (1) (a) The department $\star \star \star \underline{shall}$ develop,		
9	<pre>implement and regulate a * * * mandatory harvest reporting program</pre>		
10	for white-tailed deer and/or wild turkey, to collect and compile		
11	harvest data * * * of such quality and quantity as to be able to		
12	assist the legislature and the commission in formulating the		
13	wildlife resource conservation policy for the State of		
14	Mississippi. The harvest reporting program authorized by this		
15	section shall be a system that will be simple and usable by all		
16	sportsmen so as to promote compliance and accurate reporting and		
17	may include, but not be limited to, such means as a mobile		
18	smartphone application, oneline web-based reporting, or such other		

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19 <u>electronic or digital method(s) as shall promote ease of use by</u>
20 <u>sportsmen</u>.

22 (* * * b) The department shall provide an annual report 23 to the Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks Committees of the Senate and 24 the House of Representatives.

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26 (***<u>2</u>) A person who violates any law or regulation * * *
27 <u>implementing and/or regulating</u> the * * * <u>harvest reporting system</u>
28 is guilty of a Class * * * <u>II</u> violation and shall be subject to
29 the fines provided in * * * <u>Section 49-7-143</u>. In addition, a
30 person shall be assessed the administrative fee prescribed in this
31 section.

32 (a) A person convicted of a first violation of (* * *3) 33 the * * * harvest reporting program shall be assessed an administrative fee of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) 34 35 nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), which shall be imposed and collected upon conviction. A person convicted of a 36 37 second or subsequent violation shall be assessed an administrative 38 fee of not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) nor more than 39 One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), which shall be imposed and 40 collected upon conviction.

(b) The clerk of the court shall collect and deposit
the administrative fees with the State Treasurer, in the same
manner and in accordance with the same procedure, as nearly as

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46 (c) The administrative fees shall be credited to the
47 Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks and may be expended by
48 the department upon appropriation by the Legislature.

49 (* * *<u>4</u>) Each deer or turkey taken or possessed in 50 violation of the * * * <u>harvest reporting</u> program is a separate 51 offense.

52 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 53 and after July 1, 2018.
