HOUSE BILL NO. 1028

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-26, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND 2 3 PARKS TO DEVELOP A PROGRAM FOR TAGGING WHITE-TAILED DEER AND WILD TURKEY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 49-7-26, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 49-7-26. (1) (a) The department * * * shall develop, 8 9 implement and regulate a tagging and reporting program for 10 white-tailed deer and wild turkey, to collect harvest data and monitor bag limit compliance by any means as provided in this 11 12 section. * * * 13 14 (* * *b) The department shall provide an annual report to the Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks Committees of the Senate and 15 the House of Representatives. 16 17 * * * (* * *2) A person who violates any law or regulation of 18

- 28 violation shall be assessed an administrative fee of not less than
- 29 Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) nor more than One Thousand Dollars
- 30 (\$1,000.00), which shall be imposed and collected upon conviction.
- 31 (b) The clerk of the court shall collect and deposit
- 32 the administrative fees with the State Treasurer, in the same
- 33 manner and in accordance with the same procedure, as nearly as
- 34 practicable, as required for the collection and deposit of state
- 35 assessments under Section 99-19-73.
- 36 (c) The administrative fees shall be credited to the
- 37 Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks and may be expended by
- 38 the department upon appropriation by the Legislature.
- 39 (* * *4) Each deer or turkey taken or possessed in
- 40 violation of the tagging program is a separate offense.
- 41 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 42 and after July 1, 2018.
