- Mississippi shall consist of all territory included within the 8
- 9 boundaries described in the act of Congress of March 1, 1817,
- together with all territory ceded to the State of Mississippi by 10
- 11 later acts of Congress or by compacts or agreements with other
- states, as such territory and boundaries may have been or may be 12
- 13 modified by the United States Supreme Court, which extends three
- 14 (3) miles South of Cat Island, Ship Island, Horn Island and Petit
- 15 Bois Island off shore to three (3) Marine Leagues.
