HOUSE BILL NO. 1474

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO SEAGIE J. PACE OF
2 LAMAR COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Seagie J. Pace of Lamar County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction for possession of a controlled substance with intent in
8 Lamar County, Mississippi, in 2006, and who has completed the
9 penalty and all conditions imposed upon him for such conviction.
10 The Legislature has been reliably informed that he is now
11 conducting himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a
12 good and lawful manner.

13 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
14 and after its passage.
