HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 57

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING JIM ELLIS UPON HIS RETIREMENT FROM
CALLING MISSISSIPPI STATE UNIVERSITY FOOTBALL AND MEN'S BASKETBALL
GAMES, AND EXTENDING BEST WISHES FOR CONTINUED SUCCESS IN CALLING
MSU BASEBALL GAMES.

5 WHEREAS, after beginning his broadcasting career with 6 Mississippi State University in 1979, Jim Ellis is semi-retiring 7 from his profession, as he is stepping away from broadcasting the 8 Bulldogs football and men's basketball games but will continue to 9 call MSU baseball games, the job that he was originally hired for; 10 and

11 WHEREAS, the move to a lighter schedule had been in the works 12 for a few years now, and although he will of course miss calling 13 all three sports, the new schedule will allow him to spend more 14 time with his wife and seven grandchildren; and 15 WHEREAS, a native of West Point and a 1969 graduate of

16 Mississippi State, Mr. Ellis assumed the play-by-play role for 17 football and men's basketball at the start of the 2011-2012

18 athletic season following the retirement of legendary voice Jack

19 Cristil; and

20 WHEREAS, after Cristil's retirement, Ellis could have tried 21 to imitate his predecessor's style, but Ellis kept true to his 22 authentic, deliberate, detailed and straight-forward approach that 23 resonates with Bulldog fans; and

24 WHEREAS, in recognition of his truly remarkable talent for 25 broadcasting, Ellis was named "Outstanding Broadcaster in 26 Mississippi" by the National Sports Media Association on four 27 occasions, 1998, 2002, 2013 and 2014; and

28 WHEREAS, although Bulldog fans will be hearing less of Ellis' 29 impeccable calling, they will still hear him every time they tune 30 into a baseball game, as he has no plans on stepping away from the 31 baseball booth anytime soon; and

32 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to 33 recognize the great voices of our state's athletic powerhouses, 34 such as Jim Ellis, whose retirement from calling Bulldogs football 35 and men's basketball games will leave a void that will not be 36 easily replaced:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend the career of Jim Ellis upon his retirement from calling football and men's basketball games for Mississippi State University, and extend best wishes for continued success calling MSU baseball games.
