SENATE BILL NO. 2006 (As Sent to Governor)

- AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO ADOPT
 REGULATIONS TO SPECIFY THE INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED IN THE
 WRITTEN REPORT FURNISHED TO PATIENTS RECEIVING MAMMOGRAM SERVICES;
 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, the following terms
 7 shall be defined as provided in this subsection:
- 8 (a) "Department" means the State Department of Health.
- 9 (b) "Mammography" means radiography of the breast for
- 10 the purpose of enabling a physician to determine the presence,
- 11 size, location and extent of cancerous or potentially cancerous
- 12 tissue in the breast.
- 13 (c) "Radiography" means the making of a film or other
- 14 record of an internal structure of the body by passing x-rays or
- 15 gamma rays through the body to act on film or other image
- 16 receptor.
- 17 (2) The department shall adopt regulations that specify the
- 18 information to be provided to patients receiving mammogram

19 services in the written report of the mammography results that is

- 20 furnished by the entity performing the mammography services
- 21 directly to patients under the federal Mammography Quality
- 22 Standards Act, 42 USC Section 263b. Any information that the
- 23 department requires to be provided in the report shall be
- 24 evidence-based, consistent with accepted medical standards, and
- 25 not inconsistent with the federal Mammography Quality Standards
- 26 Act or regulations promulgated under that act.
- 27 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 28 and after July 1, 2017.
