26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

27 **SECTION 1.** (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a

28 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge

29 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as

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30 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 31 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 32 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor 33 34 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a 35 supporter of Aunt Joyce's Kids. The distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and design as the Department of 36 37 Revenue, with the advice of Aunt Joyce's Kids, may prescribe and 38 shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be 39 necessary to distinguish each license tag.

40 (2)Application for the distinctive license tags authorized by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 41 42 prescribed by the Department of Revenue. The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 43 44 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, 45 shall be remitted to the Department of Revenue on a monthly basis 46 as prescribed by the department. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 47 48 county general fund.

(3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or after July 1, 2017, any person applying for a distinctive license tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a

The additional fee is due and payable at the 57 time the original application is made for a distinctive license 58 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 59 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 60 license taq.
