## SENATE BILL NO. 2383

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 75-47-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE ANNUAL REPORTING OF NET TONS OF FERTILIZER DISTRIBUTED IN THE STATE AND PAYMENT OF INSPECTION FEES; TO AMEND SECTION 75-47-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CONFORM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 75-47-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 75-47-11. (1) There shall be paid to the commissioner for
- 10 all commercial fertilizers distributed in this state an inspection
- 11 fee at the rate of Twenty-five Cents (25¢) per ton, provided that
- 12 sales to manufacturers or exchanges between them are hereby
- 13 exempted. Fees so collected shall be used for the payment of the
- 14 costs, by act of the Legislature, of inspection, sampling and
- 15 analysis, and other expenses necessary for the administration of
- 16 this chapter. On individual packages of commercial fertilizer
- 17 containing ten (10) pounds or less, there shall be paid in lieu of
- 18 the annual registration fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per brand and
- 19 grade and the Twenty-five Cent (25¢) per ton inspection fee, an

- 20 annual registration fee and inspection fee of Fifty Dollars
- 21 (\$50.00) for each brand and grade sold or distributed. Where a
- 22 person sells commercial fertilizer in packages of ten (10) pounds
- 23 or less and in packages over ten (10) pounds, this annual
- 24 registration and inspection fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) shall
- 25 apply only to that portion sold in packages of ten (10) pounds or
- less, and that portion sold in packages over ten (10) pounds shall
- 27 be subject to the same inspection fee of Twenty-five Cents (25¢)
- 28 per ton as provided in this chapter.
- 29 (2) Every registrant or guarantor who distributes a
- 30 commercial fertilizer in this state shall file with the
- 31 commissioner, on forms furnished by the commissioner, \* \* \* an
- 32 annual statement, setting forth the number of net tons of each
- 33 commercial fertilizer distributed in this state during \* \* \* the
- 34 previous year. The report shall be due on or before the thirtieth
- 35 day of the month following the close of each quarter. Upon such
- 36 statement the registrant shall pay the inspection fee at the rate
- 37 stated in \* \* \* subsection (1) of this section.
- 38 If the tonnage report is not filed and the payment of
- 39 inspection fee is not made within thirty (30) days after the end
- 40 of the \* \* \* reporting year, a collection fee amounting to ten
- 41 percent (10%) of the amount, but in no case less than Ten Dollars
- 42 (\$10.00), shall be assessed against the registrant, and the amount
- 43 of fees due shall constitute a debt and become the basis of a
- 44 judgment against the registrant.

- 45 (3) When more than one person is involved in the
- 46 distribution of a commercial fertilizer, the last person who has
- 47 the fertilizer registered and who distributes to a nonregistrant,
- 48 dealer or consumer, is responsible for reporting the tonnage and
- 49 paying the inspection fee.
- 50 **SECTION 2.** Section 75-47-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 51 amended as follows:
- 52 75-47-13. All fertilizer registrants transacting,
- 53 distributing or selling commercial fertilizer to a nonregistrant
- 54 shall file with the commissioner  $\star$   $\star$  an annual report showing
- 55 the county code of the consignee, each grade of commercial
- 56 fertilizer, the amounts in tons, the Uniform Fertilizer Tonnage
- 57 Reporting System (UFTRS) code, the form in which the fertilizer
- 58 was distributed (bag, bulk or liquid) and the use (farm or
- 59 non-farm). This report of tonnage sold shall be reported by one
- 60 (1) of the following methods:
- 61 (a) Submitting a summary report on forms furnished by
- 62 the commissioner; or
- (b) Submitting an electronic disk format or text file
- 64 acceptable to the UFTRS. Each reporting method shall be due \* \*  $\star$
- 65 as set forth in Section 75-47-11(2). No information furnished to
- 66 the commissioner under this section shall be disclosed in such a
- 67 way as to divulge the methods of operation of any registrant.
- 68 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 69 and after July 1, 2017.
