SENATE BILL NO. 2003

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND 2 MAINTENANCE OF THE OFFICE OF STATE AID ROAD CONSTRUCTION OF THE 3 MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Office of State Aid Road Construction Fund, 7 8 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Office of State 9 Aid Road Construction of the Mississippi Department of Transportation for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, and 10 11 ending June 30, 2018.....\$ 175,214,260.00. 12 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act, the following positions are authorized: 13 14 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: Permanent: Full Time..... 54 15 Part Time.... 16 0 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 17 0 18 Part Time.... 0

19 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 20 responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2019 do not 21 22 exceed Fiscal Year 2018 funds appropriated for that purpose, 23 unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 24 2018 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel 25 26 Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to 27 fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 28 29 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 30 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2018 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the 31 32 exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 33 34 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 35 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2018 "Personal Services" 36 37 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 38 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 39 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 40 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State

The 46 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 47 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 48 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 49 appropriated level.

50 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 51 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 52 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 53 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, it is the 58 59 intention of the Legislature that an amount not to exceed Five 60 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) is authorized to be expended from funds received from the Mississippi Development 61 62 Authority as reimbursements for actual expenses incurred by the 63 Office of State Aid Road Construction for administering and 64 providing engineering services to political subdivisions as 65 authorized under Section 65-4-15, Mississippi Code of 1972. Any such funds shall be deposited into the Office of State Aid Roads 66 67 Administrative Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, 68 and ending June 30, 2018.

69 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, it is the 70 intention of the Legislature that an amount not to exceed Thirty 71 Million Dollars (\$30,000,000.00) is authorized to be expended for 72 the purpose of replacement of structurally deficient bridges on 73 the Local System Bridge Program (LSBP).

74 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 75 Office of State Aid Road Construction shall maintain complete 76 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 77 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 78 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 79 Year 2017. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 80 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2019 shall be 81 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 82 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 83 provided during the Fiscal Year 2018 budget request process.

84 SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 85 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 86 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 87 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 88 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, 89 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted 90 performance measures provided below:

144 which the Legislature has made funds available. Any signage 145 regarding any public event or any new facility, roadway or bridge 146 shall include the following language: "Funds were made available 147 for this project by the Mississippi State Legislature." The 148 signage shall further state the four-year legislative term in 149 which the project was funded.

150 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature to 151 authorize the State Aid Engineer to utilize funds available to the 152 Office of State Aid Road Construction, from any source herein 153 appropriated or made available by the counties or any other 154 source, to pay for costs necessary to comply with the National 155 Bridge Inspection Standards and the Federal Highway 156 Administration's requirements for bridge inspections and/or 157 special studies necessary to comply with federal laws. The State 158 Aid Engineer shall follow the same procedures as have heretofore 159 been established by Sections 65-9-9, 65-9-15 and 65-9-17, 160 Mississippi Code of 1972, for payment of such costs. The Office 161 of State Aid Road Construction may accept, budget and expend these 162 funds subject to and in accordance with rules and regulations of 163 the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner 164 consistent with the escalation of federal or state funds.

165 **SECTION 9.** It is the intention of the Legislature that in 166 the letting of contracts for which the Office of State Aid Road 167 Construction administers and provides engineering services to 168 political subdivisions under the Economic Development Highway Act,

No. 2003 171E/SS05/A947 PAGE 7 (mm\mm) bids may be made from the lowest and best bidder after advertising for competitive sealed bids once in a newspaper published or having a circulation in the county or municipality where the contract will be performed, and the date published for the bid opening may be not less than seven (7) working days after the advertisement is published.

175 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that 176 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 177 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 178 179 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 180 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 181 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 182 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for actions contrary to this provision.

190 **SECTION 12.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 191 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 192 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 193 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
