1 2 3 4	A RESOLUTION REMEMBERING THE GALLANT SERVICE AND COMMENDING THE LIFE OF MISSISSIPPI ARMY NATIONAL GUARD SERGEANT KYLE THOMAS OF AMORY, MISSISSIPPI, WHO WAS LOST IN A TRAINING EXERCISE IN CALIFORNIA ON MONDAY, MAY 29, 2017.
5	WHEREAS, a Mississippi Army National Guard soldier from
6	Amory, Mississippi, was lost in a training exercise in California
7	Twenty-four-year-old Sergeant Kyle Thomas of the 155th Armored
8	Brigade Combat Team died Monday, May 29, 2017, in an accident at
9	the National Training Center at Fort Irwin, California; and
10	WHEREAS, Sergeant Thomas was assigned to the 2d Battalion,
11	198th Armored Regiment, and was among four 2-198 R soldiers
12	conducting combat maneuver operations in a M1A2 SEPv2 Abrams Main
13	Battle Tank; and
14	WHEREAS, Sergeant Thomas was born on December 10, 1992, in
15	Amory, Mississippi, the son of Eddie Thomas and JoAnn Boussouar.
16	He graduated from Amory High School in 2011. On May 1, 2017, he
17	became a father, and leaves behind a daughter, Devina Smith. His

graveside service with military honors will be held in Amory on

June 9, 2017. Pallbearers will be members of the Mississippi
