  - TIME IN SCHOOL HISTORY.
- 6 WHEREAS, the Ole Miss Softball Team made a significant
- 7 breakthrough in the 2017 season. For the first time in school
- 8 history, the Ole Miss Softball Team, led by Head Coach Mike Smith
- 9 and his staff, won their first-ever SEC Title and clinched their
- 10 first-ever Super Regional appearance with a 7-2 win over North
- 11 Carolina on May 21, 2017, to win their NCAA Regional Championship
- 12 in front of a crowd of 1,709 fans, a program record, with many
- 13 fans following the game outside the stadium; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the Rebels (43-18) capped off what turned into a
- 15 memorable weekend in Oxford that saw two record crowds and almost
- 16 5,000 fans cross through the gates of the Ole Miss Softball
- 17 Complex. Through three games in the regional, Ole Miss allowed
- 18 only two runs, and piled on 17 to claim its seventh-straight win;
- 19 and

20	WHEREAS, as has been the case for the latter part of the
21	season, the Rebels relied on the arm of Kaitlin Lee, who again
22	earned her way to another stellar victory. She threw her school
23	record 12th-straight complete game, and allowed only two runs off
24	five hits, with six strikeouts to settle in after the first two
25	innings. Lee had been on a roll since the regular season ended.
26	Since the start of the SEC Tournament, she won seven consecutive
27	games, pitched every inning of all seven, and allowed five runs in
28	47 innings. Kaitlin has been the main character in Ole Miss'
29	surprising run to a Super Regional; and
30	WHEREAS, offensively, Elantra Cox again paved the way going
31	3-for-3, while Brittany Finney had the go-ahead, 2-run blast in
32	the six that gave the Rebels the lead. Senior Miranda Strother,
33	in potentially her final home game as a Rebel, made it a big one
34	with a 3-for-4 performance and two RBIs and two runs scored; and
35	WHEREAS, as a team the Rebels finished the Regional weekend
36	outscoring its three opponents 17-2, and trailed only once for
37	three innings in the Championship Game; and
38	WHEREAS, at the Regional, junior RHP Kaitlin Lee continued
39	her dominating streak of 12 consecutive complete games, which
40	further extends her school record. She capped the weekend with
41	only the two runs allowed on Sunday, and threw two shutouts,
42	struck out 11, and surrendered only 12 hits. Kaitlin has also
43	tied Madi Osias' single-season record from a year ago with her

- 44 23rd game, and tied Amanda Fine's single-season school record with
- 45 26 complete games; and
- WHEREAS, Ole Miss, which played in its first-ever Super
- 47 Regional, began playing softball in 1997. In their first 18
- 48 seasons, the Rebels posted a winning record twice. The challenges
- 49 were apparent right away. "Sometimes it's just the perfect
- 50 synergy of people that you put together. Just the culture Coach
- 51 Mike Smith created, the environment he created has led to some
- 52 phenomenal success. He is an amazing coach," first Coach Joyce
- 53 Maudie said. "This is exactly what I envisioned would happen with
- 54 the Ole Miss softball program back in 1995 when I was initially
- 55 talking about the program and the future of it." For the Rebels,
- 56 that future is here; and
