- 14 Coach Justin Reed said. "Set your goals at the beginning of the
- 15 year and each one of them, this was our goal." They all believed.
- 16 From the moment the Golden Wave Baseball Team stepped inside
- 17 Trustmark Park's foul lines they knew they weren't leaving without
- 18 the Golden Glove; and

- 19 WHEREAS, the seven fielders behind junior southpaw Josh Smith
- 20 and one in front were locked in from the first pitch until the
- 21 last. Smith threw seven complete innings, giving up just four
- 22 hits and walking one batter while striking out five. There were
- 23 just two innings of the seven that Tupelo saw more than four
- 24 batters. The game was filled with clutch plays, none more
- 25 important than Smith's performance in the top of the fourth.
- 26 Smith struck out two batters, and said he knew after that it was
- 27 the Golden Wave's game. Offensively, Smith got all the run
- 28 support he would need from the bats of South Sanders and Charlie
- 29 Greer; and
