HOUSE BILL NO. 34

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-106-37, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REVISE THE MINIMUM STANDARDS OF QUALIFICATIONS AND ELIGIBILITY 3 REQUIREMENTS FOR TEACHER EDUCATION SCHOLARS FORGIVABLE LOAN 4 PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 37-106-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

37-106-37. (1) There is created the Teacher Education 8 9 Scholars Forgivable Loan Program to be administered by the board. 10 The program shall provide an annual forgivable loan not to exceed Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) for each approved teacher 11 12 education scholar who is enrolled in one of Mississippi's public 13 or private universities in the junior year and is admitted into a 14 teacher education program. Additionally, the program shall provide an annual scholarship not to exceed Fifteen Thousand 15 Dollars (\$15,000.00) for each approved teacher education scholar 16 17 who is enrolled in one (1) of Mississippi's public or private universities in the freshman year and intends to enter into a 18 19 teacher education program.

(3) A student may receive a forgivable loan from the program
for four (4) consecutive years if the student remains enrolled
full time in the program and makes satisfactory progress toward a
baccalaureate degree with a major in education.

26 If a teacher education scholar graduates and is (4) (a) 27 employed as a teacher by a Mississippi district school board, the 28 scholar is not required to repay the forgivable loan amount so 29 long as the scholar teaches in a Mississippi public school. The 30 entire forgivable loan amount shall be forgiven if the scholar remains employed as a Mississippi public school teacher for five 31 32 (5) years.

33 Any teacher who enters the education scholar (b) program and graduates, and is employed as a teacher by a 34 35 Mississippi public school board, in a school rated as "D" or "F," 36 in addition to being exempt from the repayment of loan requirement while employed as a Mississippi public school teacher, such 37 38 teacher education scholar shall also receive an annual salary 39 supplement of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) for each year the scholar remains in the "D" or "F" school, up to a maximum of five 40 (5) years. Each scholar employed in a Mississippi public school 41 under the provisions of this paragraph shall endeavor, within the 42 43 five-year period of initial employment, to fulfill the necessary requirements to acquire a Master Teacher certificate from the 44

45 National Board of Professional Teaching Standards, at which time 46 the scholar shall be eligible to receive an annual salary supplement for such National Board Certified teachers under the 47 provisions of Section 37-19-7(2)(a)(i). However, if any teacher 48 49 education scholar graduate receiving an annual salary supplement 50 provided for in this paragraph (b) shall complete the certification requirements to become a National Board Certified 51 52 teacher within the five-year period of eligibility for salary 53 supplementation, that teacher shall be entitled to only the annual salary supplement provided for such National Board Certified 54 55 teachers, such that the teacher receives only one (1) annual 56 salary supplement of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00).

57 (5) Repayment and conversion terms shall be the same as 58 those outlined in Section 37-106-53.

59 (6) The board shall promulgate such rules as are necessary 60 to administer the teacher education scholars program and establish 61 necessary eligibility criteria not specifically set forth in this 62 section.

63 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 64 and after July 1, 2018.
