## HOUSE BILL NO. 123

- AN ACT TO PROHIBIT PERSONS FROM KNOWINGLY SMOKING IN A MOTOR VEHICLE IN WHICH A CHILD WHO IS LESS THAN SIX YEARS OF AGE IS A
- 3 PASSENGER; TO PROVIDE THAT A VIOLATION OF THIS ACT IS A
- 4 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY A FINE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** (1) This section shall be known and may be cited
- 7 as the "Mississippi Protection from Secondhand Smoke for Children
- 8 Act."
- 9 (2) As used in this section:
- 10 (a) "Motor vehicle" means any motor vehicle, except a
- 11 school bus, a church bus, or other public conveyance, that is
- 12 required by federal or state law or regulation to be equipped with
- 13 a passenger restraint system.
- 14 (b) "Smoke" means inhaling, exhaling, burning, carrying
- or otherwise possessing any lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or any
- 16 other object or device that contains lighted tobacco.
- 17 (3) A person shall not knowingly smoke in a motor vehicle in
- 18 which a child who is less than six (6) years of age is a
- 19 passenger.
