HOUSE BILL NO. 214

1 AN ACT TO CREATE THE SMALL SCHOOL DISTRICT EQUIPMENT, 2 MAINTENANCE AND INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT FUND (DEMI GRANT); TO PROVIDE 3 THAT GRANT FUNDS SHALL BE AWARDED FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSISTING 4 ELIGIBLE SCHOOL DISTRICTS WITH ENROLLED STUDENT POPULATIONS OF 5 4,500 STUDENTS OR LESS TO OFFSET EXPENSES FOR SCHOOL EQUIPMENT, 6 MAINTENANCE OF PHYSICAL PLANTS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO INFRASTRUCTURE; 7 TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF \$2,000,000.00 FOR THE INITIAL YEAR OF THE FUND'S ESTABLISHMENT; TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT 8 OF EDUCATION SHALL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM AND MAKE THE 9 10 DETERMINATION OF THOSE APPLICANTS ELIGIBLE FOR AND APPROVED FOR 11 RECEIPT OF GRANTS; TO PROVIDE THAT APPLICANTS APPROVED FOR RECEIPT 12 OF A GRANT SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE RECEIPT OF A ONE-TIME GRANT IN 13 AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$150,000.00; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

15 **SECTION 1.** As used in this act, the following terms shall

16 have the meaning ascribed under this section, unless the context

17 of use indicates otherwise:

(a) "Fund" means the "Small School District Equipment,
Maintenance and Infrastructure Grant Fund," which may be referred
to as the "DEMI Grant Fund" established under Section 2.

(b) "Applicant" means any small school district with an
enrolled student population of four thousand five hundred (4,500)
students or less that applies for a grant under Section 4.

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24 (c) "Department" means the State Department of25 Education.

26 The Small School District Equipment, SECTION 2. (1) 27 Maintenance and Infrastructure Grant Fund (DEMI Grant) is 28 established for the purpose of providing grants to small school 29 districts with an enrolled student population of four thousand 30 five hundred (4,500) students or less which are experiencing 31 budget shortfalls, and which are awarded a grant by the State 32 Department of Education under this act to eligible districts to 33 offset expenses for school equipment, maintenance of its physical 34 plant and improvements to the district's infrastructure.

35 (2) The fund shall consist of monies appropriated by the 36 Legislature and gifts and grants to the fund by any public or 37 private entity, which shall consist of an initial legislative 38 appropriation of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) for the 39 program's establishment for fiscal year 2019.

40 (3) The State Department of Education shall administer the 41 fund, and any expenses incurred for its administration shall be 42 paid from monies in the fund. Monies remaining in the fund at the 43 end of the fiscal year, which are unencumbered, shall remain 44 inviolate and not lapse into the State General Fund.

(4) The State Treasurer shall invest the money in the fund not immediately needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same manner as other public funds may be invested. Funds shall be

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50 The State Department of Education may award **SECTION 3.** (1) 51 a District Equipment, Maintenance and Infrastructure Grant (DEMI 52 Grant) to applicants under this act to aid eligible school 53 districts that are experiencing budget shortfalls in its efforts to provide a safe and orderly school environment for students and 54 55 staff of the district through the purchase of essential equipment 56 and/or defraying the costs of necessary maintenance and improvements to infrastructure that meet the criteria established 57 58 by the department under the authority of this section.

59 (2) The department shall develop criteria for approving60 applications submitted under Section 4 of this act.

(3) When considering whether to award a DEMI Grant to an
applicant under this act, the department shall consider
whether the application submitted by the applicant under Section 4
of this act:

(a) Increases cost efficiencies relating to the use ofschool facilities;

(b) Reduces debt incurred by the district for providing
equipment, maintenance and infrastructure of one or more schools
in the district; or

(c) Establishes any other measure that wouldsignificantly reduce costs related to the provision of additional

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74 The department shall establish the terms of awarding a (4) 75 DEMI Grant to an applicant under this chapter. The department 76 shall establish guidelines for determining the amount of a grant 77 awarded to an applicant based on the severity of conditions in the 78 school district which necessitate the need for grant funds and on 79 the amount of cost savings passed along to the applicant. A DEMI 80 Grant awarded under this act shall not exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00). Applicants approved by the 81 82 department for receipt of a grant under this act, shall be 83 entitled to the receipt of only one (1) grant during the grant 84 program's administration.

85 The local school board of a school district SECTION 4. (1) 86 may apply for a DEMI Grant under this act in the manner prescribed 87 by the department under the provisions of this act, and any rules 88 promulgated by the State Board of Education for the administration of the grant program. The application must include a plan 89 90 submitted by the applicant, and the department may require the 91 applicant to include a cost analysis study of the proposed plan. 92 (2)If an applicant receives a grant under this act, the 93 grant shall be used to implement the plan submitted to the state board under subsection (1) and may be used to pay any costs 94 95 associated with preparing any cost analysis study associated with 96 the plan.

97 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 98 and after July 1, 2018.

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
