AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 3-3-61, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
1972, TO DESIGNATE "MISSISSIPPI" BY ED THOMAS, AS THE OFFICIAL
STATE SONG OF MISSISSIPPI; TO REPEAL CHAPTER 654, LAWS OF 1962,
WHICH DESIGNATED "GO MISSISSIPPI" AS THE OFFICIAL STATE SONG; AND
FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section

8 3-3-61, Mississippi Code of 1972:

9 3-3-61. The lyrics and music in the song entitled

10 "Mississippi" by Ed Thomas, are designated as the official state

- 11 song of the State of Mississippi. The lyrics of the song are:

25 **SECTION 2.** Chapter 654, Laws of 1962, which designated "Go 26 Mississippi" as the official song of the State of Mississippi, is 27 repealed.

28 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 29 and after July 1, 2018.
