## HOUSE BILL NO. 236

- AN ACT TO PROHIBIT ALTERING THE SERIAL NUMBER OF A FIREARM;
  TO PROHIBIT THE POSSESSION OF SUCH FIREARMS; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES
  FOR VIOLATIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) A person shall not knowingly buy, sell,
- 6 ship, transport, pawn, receive, or possess any stolen firearm or
- 7 any firearm from which the manufacturer's serial number has been
- 8 altered, obliterated or removed.
- 9 (2) A person shall not knowingly alter, obliterate or remove
- 10 the manufacturer's serial number of a firearm.
- 11 (3) (a) A person violating the provisions of this section
- 12 where a death does not occur shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and,
- 13 upon conviction, shall be fined not more than Five Thousand
- 14 Dollars (\$5,000.00) or imprisoned not more than one (1) year, or
- 15 both.
- 16 (b) A person violating the provisions of this section
- 17 where a death occurs shall be guilty of a felony and, upon
- 18 conviction, shall be fined not more than Five Hundred Thousand

- 19 Dollars (\$500,000.00) or imprisoned not more than ten (10) years,
- 20 or both.
- 21 (4) For the purposes of this section, "firearm" means any
- 22 loaded or unloaded handgun, pistol, revolver, rifle, shotgun or
- 23 other weapon that will expel, is designed to expel or may readily
- 24 be converted to expel a projectile by the action of an explosive.
- 25 Firearm does not include a firearm in a permanently inoperable
- 26 condition.
- 27 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 28 and after July 1, 2018.
