HOUSE BILL NO. 245

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-37-30, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS NEAR PROPERTY WHERE 3 PETROLEUM PRODUCTS ARE LOCATED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 97-37-30, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 7 97-37-30. (1) A person who willfully discharges his or her firearm toward the dwelling of another, causing property damage to 8 9 the dwelling or any domesticated animal or livestock, is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than One Thousand 10 11 Dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisonment not exceeding twelve (12) months in the county jail, or both. 12 13 (2) A person who willfully discharges his or her firearm 14 near any business or property that contains flammable or explosive petroleum products is quilty of a felony punishable by a fine of 15 16 not more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or imprisonment not exceeding five (5) years in the custody of the Department of 17 18 Corrections, or both.
