HOUSE BILL NO. 271

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 5-1-41, 5-1-43, 5-1-45 AND 5-1-46, 2 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT ANY INCREASE OR DECREASE 3 IN THE SALARIES AND COMPENSATION AUTHORIZED BY LAW FOR 4 REPRESENTATIVES, SENATORS, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, SPEAKER OF THE 5 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE AND SPEAKER PRO 6 TEMPORE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE NEXT 7 LEGISLATIVE TERM IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE LEGISLATIVE TERM IN 8 WHICH THE LEGISLATION AUTHORIZING SUCH INCREASE OR DECREASE IS 9 PASSED INTO LAW; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 11 **SECTION 1.** Section 5-1-41, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 12 amended as follows:
- 13 5-1-41. Beginning with the 1986 Regular Session of the
- 14 Legislature of the State of Mississippi, each senator and
- 15 representative of the Legislature shall receive as compensation at
- each regular session the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00)
- 17 and the mileage allowance provided by Section 25-3-41, for each
- 18 mile of the distance by the most direct route usually traveled in
- 19 coming to and returning from the place where the Legislature sits.
- 20 Beginning on April 16, 1997, each senator and representative shall
- 21 receive for attending each extraordinary session or called session

- 22 the sum of Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) per day and mileage at
- 23 the same rate as per regular session. In addition to the above,
- 24 beginning on April 16, 1997, each senator and representative and
- 25 the Lieutenant Governor shall receive the sum of One Thousand Five
- 26 Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) per month for expenses incidental to
- 27 his or her office for every full month of his or her term, except
- 28 any month or major fraction thereof when the Legislature is
- 29 convened in regular or extraordinary session; and payments shall
- 30 be made to each senator and representative and the Lieutenant
- 31 Governor by the State Treasurer between the first and tenth day of
- 32 each month following the month for which the payments are due.
- 33 The compensation and payments authorized by this section
- 34 shall not be increased or decreased during the term of office of
- 35 the representative, senator or Lieutenant Governor, and the
- 36 effective date of any increase or decrease in the amount of
- 37 compensation authorized by this section shall begin on the first
- 38 day of the next legislative term immediately following the
- 39 legislative term in which the legislation authorizing such
- 40 increase or decrease is passed into law.
- 41 **SECTION 2.** Section 5-1-43, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 42 amended as follows:
- 43 5-1-43. (1) The salary of the Lieutenant Governor and of
- 44 the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall be Sixty
- 45 Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) annually, and they shall receive for
- 46 attending each extraordinary or called session the same

- 47 compensation and mileage as is provided for members of the
- 48 Legislature. * * *
- 49 (2) On the first day of each month, the Lieutenant Governor
- 50 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall receive in
- 51 twelve (12) equal monthly installments the compensation provided
- 52 for pursuant to subsection (1) of this section.
- 53 (3) The salary authorized by this section shall not be
- 54 increased or decreased during the term of office of the Lieutenant
- 55 Governor or Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the
- 56 effective date of any increase or decrease in the amount of salary
- 57 authorized by this section shall begin on the first day of the
- 58 term of office of the Lieutenant Governor or Speaker of the House
- of Representatives immediately following the legislative term in
- 60 which the legislation authorizing such increase or decrease is
- 61 passed into law.
- 62 **SECTION 3.** Section 5-1-45, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 63 amended as follows:
- 5-1-45. Beginning on June 4, 1997, the President Pro Tempore
- of the Senate shall receive an annual salary in an amount equal to
- 66 Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00). The salary provided for
- 67 the President Pro Tempore under this section shall be in addition
- 68 to the compensation and expense allowance established for members
- 69 of the Legislature under Section 5-1-41.
- 70 The salary authorized by this section shall not be increased
- 71 or decreased during the President Pro Tempore's term of office,

72	and	the	effective	date	of	anv	increase	or	decrease	in	the	amount

- 73 of salary authorized by this section shall begin on the first day
- 74 of the President Pro Tempore's term of office immediately
- 75 following the legislative term in which the legislation
- 76 authorizing such increase or decrease is passed into law.
- 77 **SECTION 4.** Section 5-1-46, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 78 amended as follows:
- 79 5-1-46. Beginning on June 4, 1997, the Speaker Pro Tempore
- 80 of the House of Representatives shall receive an annual salary in
- 81 an amount equal to Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00). The
- 82 salary provided for the Speaker Pro Tempore under this section
- 83 shall be in addition to the compensation and expense allowance
- 84 established for members of the Legislature under Section 5-1-41.
- The salary authorized by this section shall not be increased
- 86 or decreased during the Speaker Pro Tempore's term of office, and
- 87 the effective date of any increase or decrease in the amount of
- 88 salary authorized by this section shall begin on the first day of
- 89 the Speaker Pro Tempore's term of office immediately following the
- 90 legislative term in which the legislation authorizing such
- 91 increase or decrease is passed into law.
- 92 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 93 and after its passage.
