10	history of the State of Mississippi from the age of discovery and
11	colonization to the present with particular emphasis on the
12	significant political, social, economic and cultural issues of the
13	nineteenth and twentieth centuries which have impacted the diverse
14	ethnic and racial populations of the state.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
