HOUSE BILL NO. 318

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE THE MONTH OF MAY OF EACH YEAR AS "LYME 2 DISEASE AWARENESS MONTH"; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. WHEREAS, Lyme disease and other tick-borne illnesses are 3 found across the State of Mississippi and throughout the United 4 5 States; and 6 WHEREAS, ticks, the primary transmitter of Lyme disease, are 7 carried by animals that Mississippi citizens encounter every day; 8 and 9 WHEREAS, researchers have identified more strains and species of the Lyme spirochetal bacteria Borrelia burgdoferi in the 10 11 Southeastern United States than in any other region of the 12 country; and 13 WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimate that 300,000 people are diagnosed with Lyme disease in 14 15 the United States every year; and 16 WHEREAS, because diagnosing Lyme disease can be difficult, many people who actually have Lyme disease may be misdiagnosed 17 with other conditions; and 18 G1/2 H. 19 WHEREAS, prompt treatment with adequate antibiotic therapy in 20 the early stage of infection may cure Lyme disease; however, in 21 some cases, untreated or inadequately treated Lyme disease can 22 lead to death or permanent disability; and

23 WHEREAS, Lyme disease can affect the brain, heart, joints and 24 other organs of the body, often mimicking other illnesses; and 25 WHEREAS, all symptoms following tick bites should be taken 26 seriously; and

27 WHEREAS, the best protection from becoming seriously ill with 28 Lyme disease and other tick-borne diseases is education about 29 ticks, the diseases they carry, and proper protection and 30 prevention: NOW, THEREFORE,

31 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 32 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The month of May of each year is designated as 33 "Lyme Disease Awareness Month" to promote education and awareness 34 of Lyme disease and how it can be prevented and treated.

35 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after its passage.
