- 9 health records of a defendant during a bond or sentencing hearing.
- 10 As used in this section, the term "mental health records" means
- 11 any mental health histories, reports, summaries, diagnoses and
- 12 prognoses, treatment and medication information, notes and entries
- 13 from any mental health services provider.
- 14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 15 and after July 1, 2018.
