HOUSE BILL NO. 348

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 5-1-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 2 PROVIDE THAT THE NUMBER OF REPRESENTATIVES IN THE MISSISSIPPI 3 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES SHALL BE REDUCED TO 99 REPRESENTATIVES 4 BEGINNING WITH THE 2023 STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION; TO AMEND 5 SECTION 5-1-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE 6 NUMBER OF SENATORS IN THE MISSISSIPPI SENATE SHALL BE REDUCED TO 7 42 SENATORS BEGINNING WITH THE 2023 STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

10 SECTION 1. Section 5-1-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
