## HOUSE BILL NO. 383

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 99-19-72, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 2 TO REVISE THE FILING FEE FOR A PETITION TO EXPUNGE AN OFFENSE; TO PROVIDE THAT A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF THE FEE SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO 3 THE MISSISSIPPI CENTER FOR LEGAL SERVICES CORPORATION FUND; AND 4 5 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 99-19-72, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 99-19-72. (1) A filing fee of **\* \* \*** One Hundred Fifty-two 9 10 Dollars (\$152.00) is hereby levied on each petition to expunge an 11 offense under Section 99-19-71 to be collected by the circuit clerk and distributed as follows: 12 13 (a) One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) to be deposited into the Judicial System Operation Fund; 14 15 (b) Forty Dollars (\$40.00) to be deposited into the 16 District Attorneys Operation Fund; and 17 (c) Ten Dollars (\$10.00) to be retained by the circuit clerk collecting the fee for administration purposes \* \* \*; and 18

## 19 (d) Two Dollars (\$2.00) to be deposited into the

Mississippi Center for Legal Services Corporation Fund.

From and after July 1, 2016, the expenses of district 21 (2) 22 attorneys shall be defrayed by appropriation from the State 23 General Fund and all user charges and fees authorized by 24 paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (1) of this section shall be deposited into the State General Fund as authorized by law and as 25 26 determined by the State Fiscal Officer, and charges and fees 27 authorized by paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of this section shall be retained by the circuit clerks for expenditures 28 29 authorized by law.

30 SECTION 2. There is created in the State Treasury a special fund designated as the Mississippi Center for Legal Services 31 32 Corporation Fund. The funds shall be administered by the 33 Mississippi Center for Legal Services Corporation to the various 34 legal service centers throughout the state. The fund shall consist of monies deposited therein as provided in Section 1 of 35 36 this act and monies from any other source designated for deposit 37 into the fund. The Mississippi Center for Legal Services Corporation Fund may also accept monies from any public or private 38 39 source for deposit into the fund. Money remaining in the fund at the end of the fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General 40 41 Fund, and any interest earned from the investment of monies in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of the fund. 42
