HOUSE BILL NO. 429

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 5-1-43, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 2 INCREASE THE SALARIES OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES BEGINNING ON JANUARY 1, 2020; TO 3 AMEND SECTION 25-3-31, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE 4 5 SALARIES OF THE GOVERNOR, ATTORNEY GENERAL, SECRETARY OF STATE, COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE, STATE TREASURER, STATE AUDITOR OF 6 7 PUBLIC ACCOUNTS, COMMISSIONER OF AGRICULTURE AND COMMERCE, 8 TRANSPORTATION COMMISSIONERS AND PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSIONERS 9 BEGINNING ON JANUARY 1, 2020; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

11 SECTION 1. Section 5-1-43, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

5-1-43. (1) The salary of the Lieutenant Governor and of the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall be Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) annually, and they shall receive for attending each extraordinary or called session the same compensation and mileage as is provided for members of the Legislature. *** * ***

20 (2) On the first day of each month, the Lieutenant Governor 21 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall receive in

twelve (12) equal monthly installments the compensation provided for pursuant to subsection (1) of this section.

24 [From and after January 1, 2020, this section shall read as 25 follows:]

5-1-43. (1) The salary of the Lieutenant Governor and of the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall be *** * *** <u>Ninety</u> <u>Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00)</u> annually, and they shall receive for attending each extraordinary or called session the same compensation and mileage as is provided for members of the Legislature. *** * ***

32 (2) On the first day of each month, the Lieutenant Governor 33 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall receive in 34 twelve (12) equal monthly installments the compensation provided 35 for pursuant to subsection (1) of this section.

65 <u>SECTION 3.</u> From and after November 1, 2020, and every four 66 (4) years thereafter, the State Personnel Board shall prepare a 67 written report to the Legislature that examines, evaluates and 68 recommends an adequate level of compensation for the Governor, 69 Attorney General, Secretary of State, Commissioner of Insurance, 70 State Treasurer, State Auditor of Public Accounts, Commissioner of 71 Agriculture and Commerce, Transportation Commissioners, Public

72 Service Commissioners, Lieutenant Governor and the Speaker of the 73 House of Representatives. In preparing the report, the board 74 shall consider all appropriate factors including, but not limited 75 to, comparative salaries for each of these positions in 76 neighboring states and in the Southeast as a whole; salaries of 77 comparable professionals in government, academia, and the 78 corporate sector; changes in public sector spending; rates of 79 inflation; and the overall economic climate.

80 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 81 and after July 1, 2018.
