HOUSE BILL NO. 440

1 AN ACT TO DIRECT THE DIVISION OF MEDICAID TO CONTRACT WITH AN ENTITY TO DEVELOP, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE A DATABASE OF ELECTRONIC MEDICAL RECORDS OF MEDICAID RECIPIENTS, WHICH MAY BE ACCESSED BY MEDICAID PROVIDERS TO OBTAIN THE MEDICAL RECORDS OF MEDICAID 5 RECIPIENTS TO WHOM THEY ARE PROVIDING SERVICES; TO PROVIDE THAT THE PURPOSE OF THE DATABASE IS TO ALLOW HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS TO 6 7 BE ABLE TO COORDINATE SERVICES TO MEDICAID RECIPIENTS WITH THOSE 8 PROVIDED BY OTHER HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS IN A MANNER TO OPTIMIZE 9 THE OUALITY, EFFICIENCY AND SAFETY OF THE HEALTH CARE RECEIVED BY 10 MEDICAID RECIPIENTS; TO REQUIRE THAT THE DATABASE SHALL BE 11 DESIGNED TO LIMIT ACCESS TO THE MEDICAL RECORDS OF ANY PARTICULAR 12 INDIVIDUAL ONLY TO THOSE MEDICAID PROVIDERS WHO PROVIDE SERVICES 13 TO THAT INDIVIDUAL; TO DIRECT THE DIVISION TO ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO PROVIDE THAT MEDICAID PROVIDERS SHALL TRANSFER TO 14 15 THE ELECTRONIC MEDICAL RECORDS DATABASE THE MEDICAL RECORDS 16 INFORMATION FOR THE MEDICAID RECIPIENTS TO WHOM THEY PROVIDE 17 SERVICES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 19 SECTION 1. (1) The Division of Medicaid shall contract with 20 a qualified company or other entity to develop, maintain and 21 operate a database of electronic medical records of Medicaid 22 recipients, in order to allow health care providers to be able to 23 coordinate services to Medicaid recipients with those provided by 24 other health care providers in a manner to optimize the quality, 25 efficiency and safety of the health care received by Medicaid

- 26 recipients. Medicaid providers shall be authorized to access the
- 27 database to obtain the medical records of Medicaid recipients to
- 28 whom they are providing services. The database shall be designed
- 29 to limit access to the medical records of any particular
- 30 individual only to those Medicaid providers who provide services
- 31 to that individual.
- 32 (2) The Division of Medicaid shall adopt rules and
- 33 regulations to provide that Medicaid providers shall transfer to
- 34 the electronic medical records database the medical records
- 35 information for the Medicaid recipients to whom they provide
- 36 services, in the form and manner as specified by the division.
- 37 In addition, the division may adopt any other rules and
- 38 regulations as necessary to implement this section.
- 39 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 40 and after July 1, 2018.
