HOUSE BILL NO. 443

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE OWNER OF AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE TO 1 2 REGISTER THE VEHICLE WITH THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT OF THE COUNTY OF HIS OR HER RESIDENCE; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC 3 SAFETY TO ESTABLISH A STATEWIDE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE REGISTRATION 4 5 NETWORK DESIGNED TO PROVIDE IMMEDIATE RESPONSE TO SHERIFFS' 6 DEPARTMENTS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES WITH REGARD TO REPORTS OR 7 COMPLAINTS INVOLVING ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES; TO PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSITION OF FEES FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE 8 9 OF THE NETWORK; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

11 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The term "all-terrain vehicle" or "ATV," as 12 used in this section, means any motorized vehicle manufactured and 13 designed exclusively for off-road use that is fifty (50) inches or 14 less in width, has an unladen dry weight of seven hundred fifty 15 (750) pounds or less, travels on three (3), four (4) or more low 16 pressure tires, has a seat designed to be straddled by the 17 operator and uses handlebars for steering control.

18 (2) Beginning July 1, 2018, every owner of an all-terrain
19 vehicle who is a resident of this state, shall register that
20 vehicle with the sheriff of the county in which the owner resides.
21 Registration shall be made in duplicate on a form prepared and

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provided to the sheriff by the Mississippi Department of Public Safety. Each form shall include: (a) the name and address of the owner of the vehicle; (b) the age and sex of the owner; (c) the make, model and serial number of the vehicle; (d) the name and address of the person, firm or business from whom the vehicle was acquired or purchased and the date of acquisition or purchase; and (e) the place where the vehicle is usually kept.

29 The original registration form shall be retained by the (3) 30 sheriff in a safe and convenient file to be furnished him by the 31 board of supervisors for that purpose and also may be recorded on 32 computer or other electronic format. All registrations shall be 33 filed and arranged and/or formatted for retrieval in alphabetical order and shall be open to public inspection as required under the 34 Mississippi Public Records Act of 1983. A copy of the 35 36 registration form shall be forwarded to the Department of Public 37 Safety within thirty (30) days after completion of registration. The department shall file and maintain copies of all registrations 38 filed with it and shall establish and maintain a statewide ATV 39 registration network designed to provide immediate response to 40 sheriffs' departments and other law enforcement agencies with 41 42 regard to reports or complaints involving ATVs. At the time of 43 registration, the sheriff shall issue to the registrant a decal 44 for placement on the ATV. The decal shall be designed by the Department of Public Safety and shall be provided to the sheriff 45 by the department. Each decal shall contain a number and/or other 46

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47 vehicle identifying information as the Department of Public Safety 48 may prescribe so that the decal may be identified from a 49 reasonable distance.

50 (4) At the time of registration, the registrant shall pay to the sheriff a one-time fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00). Six Dollars 51 52 (\$6.00) of the fee shall be forwarded to the Department of Public Safety at the time that the sheriff's department is required under 53 54 subsection (3) of this section to provide the department with a 55 copy of the registration. Four Dollars (\$4.00) of the fee shall 56 be retained by the sheriff and shall be paid to the chancery clerk 57 for deposit into the general fund of the county. The fees received by the Department of Public Safety shall be deposited 58 59 into the Department of Public Safety Administrative Fund created under Section 45-1-21 and may be expended by the department, upon 60 61 appropriation by the Legislature, for the expenses the department 62 incurs in complying with the provisions of this section.

63 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 64 and after July 1, 2018.
