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HOUSE BILL NO. 446

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO 2 ESTABLISH A PROGRAM TO BE KNOWN AS "A BETTER CHANCE" OR THE "ABC 3 PROGRAM" FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING PREKINDERGARTEN INSTRUCTION 4 THROUGHOUT THE STATE VIA THE INTERNET; TO REQUIRE THE PROGRAM TO 5 INCLUDE CERTAIN COMPONENTS, INCLUDING THE DAILY DELIVERY OF 6 REAL-TIME INSTRUCTION BY A LICENSED PREKINDERGARTEN TEACHER; TO 7 REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT TO DETERMINE THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS 8 REGULARLY PARTICIPATING IN THE ABC PROGRAM AND TO REPORT TO THE 9 HOUSE AND SENATE EDUCATION COMMITTEES ON THE PROGRAM BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2020; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 10 11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 12 **SECTION 1.** (1) The State Department of Education shall 13 establish and implement a program to be known as "A Better Chance" or the "ABC Program," the purpose of which is to make 14 15 prekindergarten instruction available to all children and their 16 families or caregivers throughout the state. The ABC Program will 17 be in addition to the voluntary prekindergarten program established by the State Department of Education under Section 18 37-21-51. Beginning with the 2018-2019 school year, the ABC 19 20 Program of instruction must be delivered via the Internet and must 21 consist of daily age-appropriate instruction and activities, 22 including downloadable educational materials, for children and

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- 23 their parents based on the comprehensive early learning standards
- 24 adopted by the State Board of Education.
- 25 (2) The ABC Program must include a daily period of real-time
- 26 instruction during which a licensed prekindergarten teacher
- 27 delivers instruction via the Internet. The department shall
- 28 determine the duration of the period of real-time instruction. In
- 29 order to afford parents and caregivers the greatest opportunity to
- 30 avail children of the prekindergarten instruction, the daily
- 31 lessons and activities presented during the real-time period of
- 32 instruction must be scheduled for no less than three (3) different
- 33 times each school day. At all other times, the period of
- 34 instruction must be available on the ABC Program's webpage for
- 35 replay.
- 36 (3) The department shall develop a method to determine the
- 37 number of children throughout the state who regularly participate
- 38 in the ABC Program and to assess the progress being made by those
- 39 children. Before January 1, 2020, the department shall submit a
- 40 report to the Education Committees of the House and Senate on the
- 41 success of the ABC Program.
- 42 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 43 and after July 1, 2018.
