HOUSE BILL NO. 477

AN ACT TO REQUIRE RECIPIENTS OF BENEFITS UNDER THE 1 2 SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (SNAP) OR THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY FAMILIES (TANF) PROGRAM TO TAKE THE TEST OF 3 ADULT BASIC EDUCATION (TABE); TO PROVIDE THAT IF THE RECIPIENT 4 5 SCORES BELOW THE 12TH GRADE LEVEL IN ANY CATEGORY OF THE TABE, THE 6 RECIPIENT MUST ENROLL IN A PROGRAM OF STUDY FOR THE TABE AT A 7 COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO BECOME COMPETENT IN THOSE CATEGORIES IN WHICH 8 THE RECIPIENT IS DEFICIENT, AND TAKE THE TABE AGAIN AFTER COMPLETION OF THE PROGRAM OF STUDY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 9

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

11 SECTION 1. Each person who is eighteen (18) years of age or 12 older, who is a recipient of benefits under the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) or the Temporary Assistance 13 14 for Needy Families (TANF) program and who is not employed shall be required to take the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE). If the 15 recipient scores below the 12th grade level in any category of the 16 17 TABE, the recipient must enroll in a program of study for the TABE 18 at a community college in the state to become competent in those 19 categories in which the recipient is deficient, and take the TABE again after completion of the program of study. If the recipient 20 21 does not achieve a score at or above the 12th grade level in each

22 category on the TABE when taking it for the second time, the 23 recipient must again enroll in a program of study for the TABE at 24 a community college in the state and retake the TABE until the 25 recipient achieves a score at or above the 12th grade level in 26 each category on the TABE.

27 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 28 and after July 1, 2018.
