HOUSE BILL NO. 487

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES
2 ACTIVITY PROGRAM FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING AND
3 MAINTAINING RECREATIONAL FACILITIES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY OR NEARBY
4 COUNTY-OWNED PROPERTY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2019; TO PROVIDE THAT
5 THE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES ACTIVITY PROGRAM FUND SHALL BE
6 ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION; AND FOR RELATED
7 PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

9 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much of it as may be
10 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
11 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Recreational Facilities
12 Activity Program Fund established in the State Treasury as a trust
13 fund under House Bill No. _____, 2018 Regular Session, for the
14 purpose of providing the state's contribution to the fund for
15 constructing and maintaining recreational facilities on school
16 property or county-owned or leased property that is easily
17 accessible by schools, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018,
18 and ending June 30, 2019.....\$10,000,000.00.

19 **SECTION 2.** The funds appropriated under Section 1 of this
20 act shall be administered by the State Department of Education.



21 The department shall establish a maximum amount of funds that may
22 be provided to a particular county for the purpose of constructing
23 and maintaining recreational facilities on school property or on
24 county-owned or leased property that is easily accessible by
25 schools.

26 **SECTION 3.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
27 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund
28 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
29 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his
30 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or
31 officers in the manner provided by law.

32 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
33 and after July 1, 2018.
